### Presidents Report

As 2018 has come to a close I would like to thank WDHA officers, BODs, committee chairs, and membership. I had the wonderful opportunity to work with you in 2018 and am looking forward in continuing this collaboration in 2019.

AHA Convention 2018 was very eventful this year as the Hyatt Regency Hotel had an electrical escalator fire on Friday afternoon and 400+ hotel guests were evacuated and the hotel was closed down for the duration of the convention. We were allowed to recover out belongings late Friday and the hotel scrambled to find all guests rooms for Friday night. It was very difficult to find the guests rooms as the hotels in downtown Tulsa were sold out with the many activities in Tulsa that weekend to include the AHA Convention and Williams Route 66 Marathon. WDHA was chosen as a finalist in "all categories" for the Arabian Horse Association Club Excellence Award (CEA) but it is with heavy heart we did not succeed in winning any-one of the awards. Included in this newsletter is the other "club project" submission for CEA "M.A.N.E" My Arabians Need Equestrians.

You should have received from AHA a "Regionals Boundaries Questionnaire" The Regional Restructure Task Force was formed by AHA President Nancy Harvey earlier this year to review our current structure, decide if changes might be needed and if so, create a proposal to present to a future annual convention for consideration. Topics covered in the survey are

- Our current governance structure at 29 members is rather large. We have compared our structure to other member based horse breed and discipline related associations and found that most if not all of them operate with a smaller, more streamlined structure. Possible ways to update our structure each with its own pluses and minuses
  - Leave our structure as is in the current form
  - Leave the current Regions in place but create a new smaller governing board of directors and executive committee

***Wisconsin Desert Horse Association –*****CLUB PROJECTS: M.A.N.E. – MY ARABIANS NEED EQUESTRIANS**

This is a project that was designed to create an exciting learning environment in which to build and develop our Youth program. Kids today have so many options and ways to spend their time, we as volunteers, looked to find a way of creating a valuable experience for the kids. The fun thing about this program is that we can work on the material in google classroom, in our meetings, we can assign “homework”, keep in touch with the announcement features to connect with everyone, and this also, gives members from many different areas the option of keeping in touch and being active online, anytime of day or night.



Signing on to google classroom is relatively easy, and you just need a google account. Many kids today are already using this program through school and are very proficient in it. It has many features, and it is very easy to learn, and to use. You can add members and/or assign the classroom code to gain access to the program.



With the use of Google Classroom, we created an interactive program, consisting of files with information covering all topics regarding, horses, and also information specific to the Arabian horse. This program allows us to link directly with the AHA site, for quick and easy access when studying, or searching for information for hippology, judging or just for fun. We have created over 20 multiple choice quizzes, that can be taken by the youth members. The kids will hit submit when finished with the quiz and the quiz will auto correct, and email back the scores to the members.

We then have the member email those scores to us, and the scores are recorded for member achievement. We have applied values to different levels of achievement, those being: Basic Level, Intermediate Level, and finally the Masterclass level. Working through this program allows not only the learning process, but then the achievement portion and ability to work towards certificates, pins and patches.



We have successfully, grown our youth membership in the first year of launching our M.A.N.E. . We are excited to see what the future brings regarding this program and hope to expand to more video online teaching, including judging.

**WDHA High Point Rules**

Please Read Carefully – Effective November 1, 2012

1. Points will be counted only in the division entered.
2. Horses must be registered Purebred or Half Arabian/Anglo-Arabian.
3. Futurity/Maturity placings will count toward their respective halter or performance divisions.
4. Last owner winning points will receive the awards, but must be a WDHA Level 1 member in good standing. High Point Secretary must be promptly notified of change of ownership. In cases of joint ownership only one member is required to be a Level 1 member.
5. Horses nominated must be owned or leased by a member of WDHA in good standing.
6. Handlers and riders/trainers must also be at minimum associate members of WDHA in good standing. Exception for Open Shows ONLY: If the exhibitor is a junior (18 and under) exhibitor that shows a horse not owned by their family. Fees for associate memberships for the high point exhibitor requirement should be directly deposited or transferred into high point for use toward that calendar year high point awards.
7. Horses must be nominated before the time of winning points or the points will not count.
8. Points MUST be reported within 30 days of winning points or points will not count. Applies to each show entered.
9. Fees must be paid at time of nomination.
10. All points are to be sent directly to the High Point Secretary. The length of time for points to have accumulated is November 1 through October 31. The length of time for final points to be reported is November 1 through November 30. NO points will be accepted for year if postmarked after November 30.
11. Participants may check their points with the secretary at any time during the year, but questions about other participants will not be answered.
12. Exhibitor points will accumulate in all divisions that the horse is nominated in, including equitation and horsemanship classes.
13. Division 1 (PB Western Pleasure) and Division 5 (PB Huntseat Pleasure) are divided into two categories: Rated Shows or Open Shows. Please indicate which category you will be competing in on your nomination form. If you compete in both, both must be entered.
14. The WDHA Futurity/Maturity/Open Show may be counted in either open or rated divisions, depending on what you have entered. Please specify on the reporting form. Open classes use the "Open Show" points doubled and the Futurity/Maturity classes use the "WDHA Futurity & Maturity classes" doubled.
15. Additional divisions may be added to the high point list via sponsorship. Sponsors will pay \$35.00 to have the division listed. Sponsor must notify the secretary before June 1. If the sponsored class is sponsored for two consecutive years with 5 or more entries each year, it will be made a permanent division.

**WDHA Legion of Merit**

The WDHA Legion of Merit Trophy to be given to all horses winning 1,500 points in the High Point System. The Legion of Merit is open to registered PB and Half Arabian/Anglo Arabians. A \$50.00 entry fee is required the first year, thereafter a \$40 renomination fee will be required. Fees will be adjusted as necessary.

**WDHA Legion of Supreme Merit**

The WDHA Supreme Legion of Merit requires an additional 3,000 points. These points can start to be accumulated after the Legion of Merit has been earned. It may be entered the same year the Legion of Merit is completed, however no points will be awarded for the SLOM from the same show that the LOM was completed at. A \$65.00 entry fee is required the first year, thereafter a \$55.00 re-nomination fee will be required. Fees will be adjusted as necessary.

**WDHA LOM/SLOM Buyback Program**

1. Horses must be owned or leased by a member of WDHA in good standing.
2. Horses must have been entered in the WDHA High Point program for the years points are being bought back.
3. Legion of Merit Buyback cost is \$55.00 for each year points are being bought back.
4. Supreme Legion of Merit Buyback cost is \$70.00 for each year points are being bought back.
5. Year horse is originally nominated for Legion of Merit or Supreme Legion of Merit will be the year that determines the number of points necessary to be awarded the trophy.
6. Points bought back will not count towards any year end awards.
