General Information/Rules

- **No Smoking in any barns, buildings, arenas, or show office areas! All stall curtains and materials must be certified fire proof and/or a fire extinguisher must be present!**
- **Dogs must be leashed at all times and cleaned up after! Owners of continuously barking dogs will be asked to remove the dog from the grounds.**
- **Arena hours 6:00 am – 09:00 pm**

All Entries

- Current Original Negative Coggins required; must be presented to office staff before horse is unloaded and a copy left for the office. All out of state horses must also provide an original health certificate dated within the last 30 days and a copy.
- All entries must be made on the official entry blank for this show and be filled out completely.
- A signature of the parent is required if a minor is showing.
- All horses must be entered in the name of their registered owner(s) and under their full registered name.
- No horse may be entered on more than one form unless there are more than 3 riders/handlers (change letters to D, E, F).
- Total entry fees must accompany each entry. Make checks payable to Wisconsin Desert Horse Association. Post-dated checks will not be accepted. Open checks will be accepted at registration for added classes.
- Owners of horses entered in WDHA Futurity/Maturity classes must at minimum have a Level 1 current AHA voting membership - Single Event AHA membership does not qualify. Handlers/Exhibitors if not a Level 1 or Level 2 member must be a WDHA associate member. WDHA membership forms are available at the show office. See current WDHA Futurity/Maturity program rules at www.wdhaarabian.com for specifics regarding nominations and exhibitor requirements.
- Horse entries with penalty for WDHA Futurity/Maturity classes must be made before 6:00 pm Friday before the show.
- Registration papers should be available for horses entering breed classes.
- Stallions: AHA rules governing the showing of stallions apply.
- Refunds: Refunds on pre-paid class and AHA fees only, with presentation of veterinarian report. No refunds on office fees, stall fees, or scratched classes regardless if prepaid or open tab.
- Horses may enter Open English Type halter OR Open Western Type Halter, but not both. Horses in either of these classes may enter any other appropriate halter class.
- All horses staying overnight must have a stall.
- Age as of January 1, 2024 for all but AHA (R) classes. AHA Junior is an individual who has not reached his/her 19th birthday as of Dec 1st of the current competition year.
- Novice Horse not to have won three firsts in discipline.
- The 2-minute gate call will be strictly enforced. If tack changes are necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the show office prior to the start of the session and request a 3-minute gate hold.
- Due to unforeseeable problems with mechanical devices, the paddock and barn calls over the PA system must be considered a COURTESY. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have his/her horse at the gate at the prescribed time.
- The decision of the judge is final. Unruly horses may be asked to be removed from a class at the judge's discretion.
- Any exhibitors acting in an unsafe manner may be asked to be removed from a class at the judge's discretion.
- Neither the Wisconsin Desert Horse Association, the Arabian Horse Association, nor Sunnyview Expo Center is responsible for theft, accident or loss of any kind to any person on the grounds or to their animals.

Accident Preparedness Plan

- A local ambulance, if needed, will be summoned by a call to 911. Should the EMT or ambulance be needed, contact the Show Office, Show Manager, or Onsite POC. The EMT or the ambulance will be contacted. The Show Veterinarian can be contacted by the show office.

ACT/Academy Class Rules

Show attire is not required and, in fact, full show attire should not be worn. Dark trousers and a light-colored (usually white) long-sleeved blouse or dress shirt, helmet, and boots are usual. ACTS/Academy classes are not open to riders participating in the AHA Recognized classes at this show or at any previous show. Once you show "dressed" at a AHA recognized show in a riding class, you are no longer allowed to show in ACTS classes. Lesson horses may be used and may wear work tack. Horses of any breed are allowed. All ACTS classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show his/her horse to its best advantage and upon the riding skills of the rider. Each class should be judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class discipline with emphasis placed on the rider's ability to control the horse at all times, identify correct diagonals and leads promptly, and to control the horse's rate in a consistent manner. Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance, and effective control while commanding the proper speed of gaits and show ring placement. Headers are allowed in the line up in all walk-trot classes. HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED, only the rider's ability to control themselves and their horses and present themselves to their best advantage.

All Breed Judging Criteria

Saddleseat/Huntseat All Breed classes will use USEF Chapter EP English Pleasure Division for Saddleseat/Huntseat. Western open classes will use USEF Chapter WS Western Division. Training equipment (i.e. martingales, chains, shackles, tie-downs, etc.) are prohibited. A copy of these rules will be available at the show office.

AHA Standard Definitions

- JTR/JOTR - Junior to Ride / Junior Owner to Ride
- AATR - Adult Amateur to Ride / 19 & Over
- AAOTr - Adult Amateur Owner to Ride / 19 & over
- JUNIOR - A junior is an individual who has not reached his/her 19th birthday as of Dec 1st of the current competition year.

AHA Rules

- No rider competing in AHA Recognized (R) W/T/C classes may compete in AHA Recognized (R) W/T classes.
- Photocopies required with entries:
 - Both sides of Registration Certificate
 - Proof of Ownership if applicable - in the event of sale or lease, it is required that a copy of the sale contract, lease, or statement from the owner be submitted with the copy of the current registration certificate
 - AHA Membership/Competition Cards (owner, trainer, rider, driver, & handler) - **Copies of the actual current AHA membership card is required, or single event fees will be charged.** AHA affidavits are no longer available.
- Pre-entries postmarked by August 13th, 2024.
- Post-entries will be accepted up to 7 PM on the Friday night before the show.

AHA Membership Statement (Applies to Recognized (R) classes only)

- Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor.
- When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership.
- Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA regional or national competitions.
- Exhibitors in walk-trot 10 & under classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions but must have an AHA membership with a competition card at AHA regional and national competitions.
- Exhibitors in lead line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (bod 5/12)

AHA One Day or Value Show Entry Agreement

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing. ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT I agree as follows by signing this entry: I choose for myself (or as parent or guardian to permit a junior exhibitor) to participate voluntarily in this competition. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVES SERIOUS RISKS OF HARM, INCLUDING PERSONAL INJURIES, DEATH AND DAMAGES TO PROPERTY. ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM AND DAMAGES TO ME, MY HORSE AND PROPERTY. I hereby RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS (including from damages, costs and attorney fees) Arabian Horse Association, the Competition, the facilities, and all of their respective Agents, Servants, Employees and Volunteers (Collectively the "Released Parties") from any claims, relating to the competition and my participation in the competition, belonging to me, or legally caused by me or my Horse, for any kind of damages, losses, or injuries to myself, other persons, horses or property to the fullest extent permitted by law. I further agree to adhere to the rules set forth in the Arabian Horse Association One Day/Value Show Rules & Guidelines and understand all decisions made by the judge are deemed final and cannot be protested.

AHA Requirements

- All exhibitors entered in the (R) classes of this event must be a current AHA member with a competition card, join AHA at the show, or pay a Single Event Membership fee of \$35.00 per person. This includes any owner, trainer, driver, rider, or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse. A photocopy of your AHA membership/competition card must accompany your entry.
- AHA Membership affidavits are no longer available. If you do not have your AHA card you must pay the single event Member fee.
- There is an AHA mandatory fee of \$10.00 per horse. (\$5 AHA results processing and \$5 Resolution 9-90 fee).
- Walk-trot, Leadline and Open/All Breed riders are exempt from AHA non-member fees.

Amateur owners (Applies to Recognized (R) classes only)

- Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, with the exception of a horse registered to two distinct non-family owners. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted.)
- Two distinct non-family owners may co-own a horse and show that horse in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes as long as neither is the family member of a professional.
- The right to show horses in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes when there are two distinct non-family owners registered as the owners of said horse, does not extend to the family of these distinct non-family owners.
- A Horse that is co-owned by the two distinct non family owners must be registered with Arabian Horse Registry of America, Half Arabian Horse Registry, Anglo Arabian Horse Registry, Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or Canadian Partbred Arabian Registry, or other registry approved by the Arabian Horse Association as an "and" ownership relationship.
- Leased horses are not eligible for amateur owner classes.

Breeding/Gelding In-Hand Classes

- Class will use the In the Ring Class Procedure and the AHA Comparative Judging System will be in place.

Fire Hazard Law / No Smoking

- It is unlawful for any person to smoke in any building. VIOLATORS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW. The term "smoke" includes carrying a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or any other lighted smoking equipment. This includes show office areas, barns, livestock areas, etc. There are no indoor designated smoking areas in any of the buildings rented. Smoking or any open flame is prohibited in all buildings.
- All stall curtains and materials must be certified fire proof and/or a fire extinguisher must be present.

Lead Line

- Open to riders who are at least two years of age and have not reached their seventh birthday as of December 1, 2023.
- Rider is exempt from AHA and USEF membership requirements.

Liberty Class

- To be judged on presence, animation, and way of going.
- Time allowed per horse is 2 minutes with two handlers permitted in the ring.
- Must be caught within 2 minutes or entry will be disqualified.
- No splint boots, bell boots or whips over six feet.
- Music (if desired) must be provided to the show office prior to the beginning of the session. Tapes must be cued to the correct location, and clearly marked with horse's name, exhibitor number, and music title.

Halter Championship Classes

- 1st place either day either day qualifies for championship classes. Open to all-breeds
- Note: WDHA Futurity/Maturity classes 1st place does not qualify for CH Classes

Medical Waste

- All medical waste must be disposed of in accordance with Wisconsin medical waste guidelines.
- Sharps containers for the disposal of needles and syringes are located in front of each stalling barn.

Novice Classes

- Novice Horse not to have won three firsts in discipline.

Printing Errors

- The Show Committee is not responsible for errors in printing. Correction of any errors will be posted in the show office.

Rules and Specifications

- Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Sport Horse In Hand

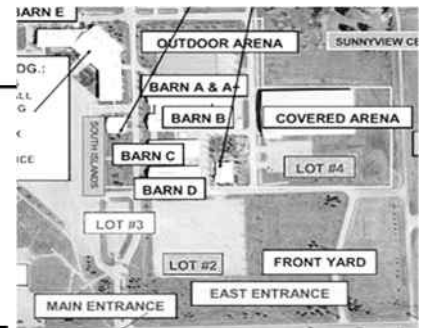
- Sport Horse in Hand classes will use the Triangle pattern.

Sport Horse Under Saddle

- Will be judged on attitude, manners, performance, suitability of horse to rider, quality and conformation.
- Will enter the ring counter-clockwise at a walk.
- To be shown both directions of the ring.

Stalls

- Shavings must be picked up near stabling barns, it will not be delivered.
- Stall deposit must be paid for tack stalls as well.
- All stall curtains and materials must be certified fire proof and/or a fire extinguisher must be present.
- Damaged Stalls will be charged a \$150.00 damage fee.
- Stalls will be available at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, August 30th, 2024.
- All horses & equipment must be removed from fairgrounds by 10 p.m., Sunday, September 1, 2024.

- **Handlers/Exhibitors** if not a Level 1 or Level 2 member must be a WDHA associate member.
- WDHA membership forms are available at the show office.
- See current WDHA Futurity/Maturity program rules for specifics regarding nominations and exhibitor requirements.
- All required information and forms are available at www.wdhaarabian.com.

All Horses on Grounds

- All horses on the grounds, whether shown or not, must have a negative Coggins, be issued a number from the office, pay for a stall or "haul-in" fee, and office fee.

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association® (AHA®) Handbook and the Value Show Rules and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules and understand all decisions made by the judge are deemed final and can not be protested.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to indemnify and hold harmless (that is pay all losses, damages, attorneys fees and costs of) the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, penalties, actions, losses, costs, damages, injuries, liabilities and obligations (including attorneys fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) my participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect (a) by me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches, drivers, contractors or invitees, or (b) by any animal owned or exhibited by me or in my custody or control.

Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

I AGREE and represent that I am qualified and eligible to enter and/or participate in the Competition and every horse I am entering is qualified and eligible as entered.

I FURTHER AGREE that by participating in an Amateur class that I am in compliance with the USEF Amateur rule.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain in effect.

The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and The Festival Show AVS; I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of USEF as published in the USEF Rule Book and on the website at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. 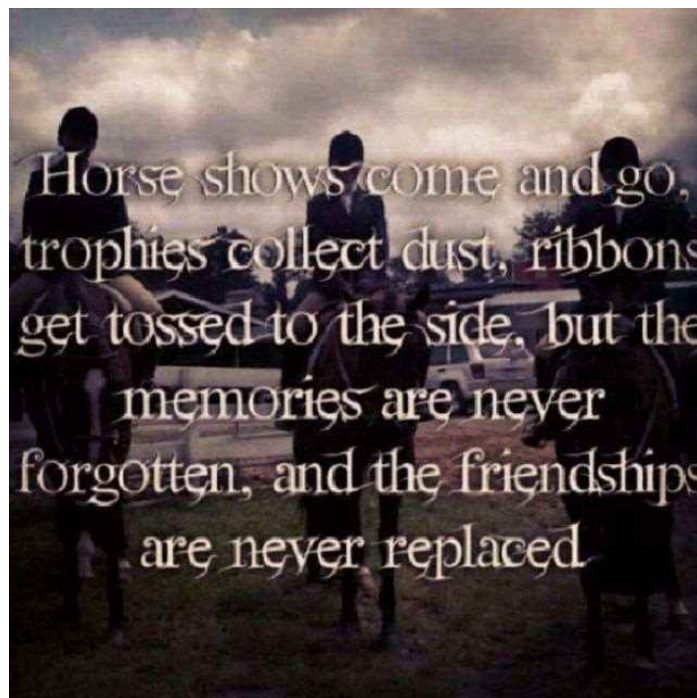
