



## HIGH POINT ANNOUNCEMENTS

**High Point Incentive:** At the General Meeting held May 9<sup>th</sup> via teleconference there were many discussions on how COVID-19 was affecting our shows, events, programs, etc. With the uncertainty when and if there would be any horse shows, exceptionally low HP nominations, it was regrettably decided to rescind the \$500 HP incentive for 2020.

### Virtual Show Points

Due to COVID-19 and the lack of face-to-face shows some are using virtual shows as an outlet. For 2020 only, High Point is adding these Virtual Divisions at the nomination fee of \$15 per division, waiving the sponsorship costs.

- PB/HA Virtual Halter
- PB/HA Virtual English
- PB/HA Virtual Hunter
- PB/HA Virtual Western
- PB/HA Virtual SHIH
- PH/HA Virtual SHUS
- PB/HA Virtual Dressage

For anyone that has participated in a virtual show in 2020 before nomination I will grandfather those points and these points will also count towards the LOM or SLOM programs. Face-to-face show points will count toward current divisions and virtual show points will count toward virtual divisions, but not both.

If virtual divisions are something members want to see in the future, they can be sponsored and if the sponsored division is sponsored for two consecutive years with 5 or more entries each year, it will be made a permanent division.

## *Magic, No-Bake Peppermint Treats*

Servings: 6 treats    Time: 15 mins    Difficulty: easy

Ingredients: 6 peppermints; about a ¼ cup of water (you can add more if the mixture is still dry); 1 tablespoon of molasses; 1 cup of rolled oats.

Instructions: Mix the oats and water until everything is wet. You can add more oats or water depending on the mixture. You don't want it soggy or puddling, just damp. Add the molasses to the mixture and stir. Everything should be sticky and you can add more molasses if the mixture is still not clumping. Take a small handful and roll it into a ball. These can be adjusted to the size you want, but this mixture usually makes 4-6 horse treats. Making them slightly smaller and should yield about six treats. Take the peppermints and press one peppermint into the middle of each ball to make a cookie. Place on dish or pan with wax paper (you don't have to, but it makes it easier) and put them in the fridge until they harden.

## *Letter From a Show Participant*

The smell of pepi, laser sheen, and hoof polish. The announcements of placings and classes on deck. Seeing friends with familiar and new horses. All the things we thought 2020 would bring but changed so suddenly. I was really needing this show season after my 2020 started off to an even more unexpected start.

I have been blessed enough to own my own Half-Arabian, Splash, since I was 8. A little 6 month old weanling made its way into my life and that's where it all began. After 20+ years of halter, showmanship, hunt, western, and dressage it all came to a halt in 2019 when he came up with some serious dental issues requiring surgery. Then shortly after, he was diagnosed with liver disease. After 5 trips to a dental surgeon, 3 trips to the UW hospital, and a lot of treatment and care, he made a full recovery. Even though he was better, he went through a lot and I decided to retire him from showing so he could enjoy pasture life with some trail riding around home. Knowing how important horse showing is in my life, I started looking for a second partner and ended up on a purebred Egyptian weanling. I wanted the full lifelong experience again. So in November 2019, Grohl was added to the family. I was so excited to start working with him and show in 2020 after being unable to show in 2019.

Then, March 2020 arrived. Not only was the pandemic beginning to form into a restricted reality, my beloved Splash unexpectedly passed away. It was a freak thing, nothing to do with any of his previously healed ailments. With grief of losing a best friend that has been there 20+ years, one of the main outlets I was looking forward to was horse shows. Then, slowly one by one the cancellations began. Whether you've worked all winter long perfecting for the show season, or excited to get your new yearling in the ring, it is just crushing to see the season disappearing.

Then, WDHA announced their online horse show! It brought me such joy to be able to practice for something we haven't been able to do yet, and really gave me some positivity in my grief filled world. Minus the show clothes, we treated it just like a normal horse show, pepi, laser sheen and all! My husband played cameraman and we had our own horse show.

Having a new horse, and a yearling on top of it, I had no expectations for placings. I haven't shown halter in over 10 years and the virtual show was a perfect opportunity to practice for me, and also a chance to teach a young horse the process in the comfort of their home. Much to my surprise, we received first place in Halter-Adult Handler! To some, a virtual horse show first place might not mean much. But I swear Splash was right there with us reminding me that I can do this. I'm so thankful for Grohl coming into my life when he did and for the opportunity to be able to do the online horse show. It is the little positive moments in life that help us through the tough times, whether it is grief or the unfamiliar world a pandemic brings. I look forward to eventually seeing you all in the show ring, where the smell of pepi, the announcement of placings, and the hugging of friends will mean that much more.





## *Open Online Liberty Show Rules:*

- Show is open to any breed or gender of horse or pony who have reached 24 months of age.
- Classes are (1) Purebred Arabians, (2) Half/Anglo Arabians, (3) English-Type Horse, and (4) Western-Type Horse. Please choose the class that is most appropriate for your horse. Cross-entries will not be allowed.
- Videos must have been filmed within two weeks of entering the show.
- Videos must be 45-90 seconds long, and must be continuous, uninterrupted footage of the horse being entered (no other horses permitted in the arena or paddock).
- Videos may not be edited in any way including added music, slow motion, multiple takes/scenes, added text, or any other type of editing. No professional videos.
- Horses must be filmed in an arena or appropriately sized paddock which consists of safe footing and no dangerous obstacles. The horse's safety is of the utmost importance.
- Only two (2) people are permitted in the ring with the horse while filming, not including the videographer. There shall be no interference or participation from persons outside the arena.
- Horses must be clean but show clipping is not required.
- Braiding and plaiting are not permitted unless appropriate for the breed.
- Tails must be unbandaged and natural with the exception of fake tails if breed standards permit.
- Black or white leg wraps are permitted. No bell boots may be worn.
- Standard whips or lunge whips are permitted, not to exceed 6 feet in length. Materials such as ribbon or plastic may be attached to the end of the whip but cannot exceed 12 inches in length.
- No other shagging/shaking devices are permitted.
- No handler or whip may touch the horse during the liberty presentation.
- Horses will be double-judged on five (5) different criteria, each of which will be scored from 0-10 for a total possible score of fifty (50) points from each judge, one hundred (100) points total. Criteria are: type, animation, charisma, movement, and use of arena.
- Places will be awarded in order of highest to lowest score.
- The highest scoring horse in each class will receive a payout based on the number of entries in their respective class.
- The entry fee is \$30 per horse. Please see Entry Forms for instructions on how to submit entries.
- All entries and fees are due no later than September 5, 2020, at 11:59 p.m. Videos submissions are due no later than September 6, 2020, at 11:59 p.m.
- Once entry forms and fees have been submitted, you will be given an exhibitor number for each horse.
- Upload your videos to Youtube with the title as "Exhibitor #, Horse Name, Breed, Class #".

I think this will be an exciting new program for our Youth, and a great way to test and display your progress with receiving an AWARD PATCH AND/OR PIN that depicts your level of accomplishments.






Equestrian Sports Private Lesson Cost


