




Raise money for items the district budget doesn't cover, such as pinnies, pullovers, backpacks, socks, team photos, posters, banners, meals and club events.


Fundraising is a vital part of operating the soccer program and participation from every player is crucial. Everyone benefits, so everyone is asked to participate.

















TEAM SPIRIT WEAR


Normally, a % of the sales comes back to the Booster Club.

Organize and sell concessions during high school Varsity and JV home games and fundraising events.

Determine menu, Set pricing

Coordinate volunteers, the set-up, sales and take down of the concession stand before each home game.

Sign Up Genius will be set up for parents to sign up for games.

Players not having a game that day will also have the option to volunteer.


RESTAURANT FUNDRAISERS

Time Frame: Year-round


Coordinate with local restaurants (Five Guys, Chipotle, I HOP, etc.) for a LHS Boy's Soccer Night.

All kids participate pre-match to give a high-five to the players as they walk out onto the field!




ANNUAL ALUMNI NIGHT

Bios are read and parents/senior player walk across field and line up, players then go back to bench to start game.


Senior parents get a memory gift - picture with frames have been done in the past.

Oversee the committee that plans and coordinates end of the season banquet.


