## **Contestant Board Meeting**

**Sunday, September 21, 2025**

Leon Winfrey, KPRA President, called the meeting to order at 10:12 a.m. with a prayer. He then addressed the rumors that contestants will only be allowed to bring in a set amount of earnings to the KPRA finals from co-approved rodeos by stating that this is in fact, just a rumor. However, we increase our KPRA rodeo count to increase participation in KPRA rodeos, change the count on co-approved rodeos or have contestants nominate co-approved rodeos to count towards standings. He then stated that we would have our rules meeting in November or December.

Jennifer Baker stated that she thinks it would help our first approved rodeos if we raise the rodeo count to 12 to go qualify for finals and only co-approve 12 per co-approving association.

Tamara Reinhardt does feel like co-approving with the UPRA is beneficial to the KPRA or KPRA members. Leon explained that some of those co-approvals are requested by our rodeo committees.

Entry System – Ethan McDowell feels like changing the Team Roping to half open TR and half 40/40 TR has helped the team ropers. Jamie Schweer, KPRA entry line manager, explained that the stock contractors just wanted the performance filled. Ethan and Jamie have discussed it extensively and communicate on building the team roping as best as they can to accommodate everyone. Leon explained that sometimes the max. entries can change if allowed or requested by the stock contractor. Jamie also explained how it helps if someone moves from slack to a performance to open up the slack if it is not offered due to the performance not being full.
