Meeting called to order: Leon open with prayer and meeting was called to order at 10:11 a.m.

A big thank you was extended to the contestants on behalf of the committees. The committees and sponsors expressed great gratitude towards the contestants for the 2022 rodeo season. The KPRA 2022 year was successful financially and the finals is headed towards success as well.

Leon would like to speak on the KPRA entry system. He feels the system is working well. There are changes from the preliminary daysheets to the official daysheets following call-backs which can cause confusion. The preliminary daysheet have to be posted in order for the contestants make changes during call back so these differences should be expected. Another point of contention is the non-member/member preference. This feature is working correctly, if a member is drawn before a non-member it is typically because the member entered late.

Jarek Van Petten questioned the system with regards to an event where slack is not offered. Example: if you enter two events and one does not have slack, the system might kick you out of the steer wrestling if the team roping performance is full. Leon explained that some event performances can fill up quickly if a buddy group is entered in several events.
