Martin Campbell Field airport was the site of the Polk County Chamber of Commerce's August meeting. Located in Copperhill, Martin Campbell Field is a 24/7 modern retreat and air transportation hub offering self-service aviation fuel, as well as both large and standard size T-hangars and an on-site airframe & powerplant (A&P) inspection mechanic. The runway features LED PAPI approach lighting with pilot control capabilities making approaches and landings safer regardless if day or night! The airfield is open to general aviation, emergency services, and area businesses, and to make the trip even more convenient, on-site rental car pickup can be sched-

uled in advance. The field is managed by Whitewater Aviation, owned by Alan Frosch and his wife Jackie. Alan is a retired Air Force veteran, as well as a licensed aircraft technician and pilot. Jackie is a general aviation and military pilot, but is still active duty Air Force. She is currently serving as the Commander of U.S. Transportation Command, and has previously served as commander of air refueling squadron, flying training wing, and the Presidential Airlift Wing. Alan and Jackie commute between assignments and Copperhill at the moment, with plans to fully retire to Copperhill in the future. Martin Campbell Field is a general aviation airport located near Copperhill, Tennessee. It serves the Copper Basin region in which it is located, as well as the entirety of Polk County and surrounding areas. Martin Campbell Field consists of a 3,500 ft x 75 ft asphalt runway. The airport is located on a total of 59 acres of land approximately 3 miles (4.8 km) northeast of Copperhill, and is also located near Ducktown. Martin Campbell Field was established in December 1946
