How it works

We send out a Newsletter each **Saturday** with a list of vegetables to choose from for your basket. In the newsletter there are farm photos, recipes, storage tips and more. **Please** be on the lookout for the email. Reply back no later than **Monday evening**. If you have not requested a vacation hold or replied back by **Tuesday evening** with your order, your basket will be at the discretion of Wild Rose Organic Farm.

What if I'm away on vacation for a few weeks?

If you are planning a vacation, you may put your account on hold by notifying us at least **1 week** before the delivery day you are going to miss. **CSA** Members are able to use up to **2 vacation holds** during the season. You can make up your vacation weeks at the end of the season to extend your shares to the end of Oct. or you can donate your basket to a friend or charity of your choice. **If you forget to put your account on hold before you leave and we harvest your share, those vegetables will be donated to Agape food bank and you will not be eligible for a replacement box.*

There are a few vegetables that I don't really like. Can I skip them?

Absolutely, that's the beauty of our Market-Style CSA—it's **your choice**. However, we do encourage you to try items that may taste incredibly different than their conventional supermarket versions. You may find a new favorite!

Do I share the bounty and risks with the farm through the CSA?

Yes, Wild Rose Organic Farm makes no guarantee on what will be available. We promise to do our best to provide you with a bountiful share each week. The quantity of organic (non certified) vegetables and herbs, however, may vary from [week-to-week/month-to-month/season-to-season] due to extreme weather, insects, or other production factors despite our best efforts. Because of these factors we may need to substitute. By joining our CSA, you are agreeing to share the risk of crop failure as well as the bounty of the harvest with us and other members.

How long is your season?

Wild Rose Organic Farm produces from the beginning of June through to the Mid- October. It is also important to note that the first box selections of the season are not as full as later boxes due to the smaller variety of items we can grow in the cool, early-season temperatures. Not to fear, this will be more than made up for in the later weeks when the full mid-season harvest comes in.

How do I sign up?

Easy! It takes 2 minutes. Fill it out and mail to the farm (Wild Rose Organic Farm 16231 Steele Rd. Moose Creek Ont. K0C 1W0) with your check **payable to Diana Freeman**.

Or E mail us the application form to: diana@wildroseorganicfarm.ca with your **E transfer**.

What if I don't use my CSA credit (weeks) by the end of the season?

Your CSA membership expires November 1st. CSA members are able to use 2 vacation holds at the end of the 18 weeks. Any extra shares will be donated to the Agape Food Bank. Don't worry, nothing goes to waste.

Is it important to sign up early?

Yes! It is important to sign up and pay a deposit for your share as early as possible for two reasons: to reserve your CSA share, as memberships are limited and to help your farmer absorb the initial expenses in the beginning of the season.

Spaces are limited and are valued on a first come first served basis.

Do I have to pay all at once? (NO)

- A minimum deposit of \$100.00 (non refundable) towards your balance is required with registration to hold your spot in the program.
- If possible, please send HALF your total balance to us BEFORE April 30th . Of course if you want to mail the whole thing, that's great too.
- If 50% is too much all at once, you can break it up into as many checks as you need. The first one should be dated April 30th, 2025, and the last one has to be dated by June 1, 2025.
- We accept cash, check, or bank e-transfer payments. Sorry no credit cards ~ (We just hate those bank fees).
