Your outpost can sleep inside or outside. Provided meals will be indoors. Activities will be outside, so come prepared. You will need everything on the list, both the personal items and the items listed as “team” items if you want to master your crucible.

Where - Heartland beginning at 7:30 sharp on February 1st. You will need to be ready to begin your quest at that time so come early and get settled into your quarters. Registration will open at 5:00. Plan to head back home late afternoon on the 2nd.

As always there will be some changes from past Crucibles. All participants will receive a patch and a commemorative coin. ***** This camp is no longer a part of the Leadership Training Academy and will not count toward your saber.**

Where: Heartland Conference Retreat Center (check in at Hickory Lodge beginning at 5:00. You must be settled in by the 7:30 starting time)

When: February 1st and 2nd 2019

Cost: \$65.00 by January 18. \$85.00 after January 18.

If tent camping cost is: \$30.00 by January 18. \$40.00 after January 18. **Check with registration prior to setting up your camp.**

Meals Provided: Friday Snack & Saturday Breakfast. You will be preparing lunch outside.

PERSONAL EQUIPMENT LIST

Long underwear (can wear sweat pants and sweat shirt if long underwear not available)

Long-sleeved shirt (should be loose enough to fit over undergarments)

Long pants (should be loose enough to fit over undergarments)

Sweater (fleece or wool)

Hiking boots or sturdy shoes (gym shoes will not provide comfort and protection in cold weather)

Gym shoes for indoor activities only.

Socks (wool or synthetic)

Warm parka or jacket with hood

Stocking hat (fleece or wool)

Mittens or gloves (fleece or wool) with water-resistant shells

Rain gear

Sleeping garments

Sleeping Bag

Pillow

Toiletries: Soap, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Comb or Hair Brush, Towel, Washcloth, etc.

Bible (You will definitely need this)

Pen or Pencil

Flashlight

Canteen

Day pack

Dirty clothes bag (waterproof or a trash bag)

Cell phone use will be restricted and PLEASE – No Games

You may want to send 2 extra sets of dry clothes, 1 set for the outside activities where they might get muddy and 1 set for the ride home

IMPORTANT: TEAM ITEMS

1. You will need to have everything you require to start at least 1 cooking fire.
2. You should bring a 2-quart cooking pot and 1 gallon water container for each 8 persons attending or 1 for your outpost if less than 8 are attending. These numbers include leaders. Please mark your items.
3. You will need to bring something that resembles a mess kit to eat off of.
4. You will need to have a compass.
5. 2 extra changes of clothes. One to change into after the outdoor activities and a second change of clothes for the closing ceremony. Cloths for the closing should be what would be work to Sunday school.
6. Commanders bring your Class B utility uniform with a bolo.
7. Dads should bring clothes they would wear to Sunday school as well of the closing ceremony.

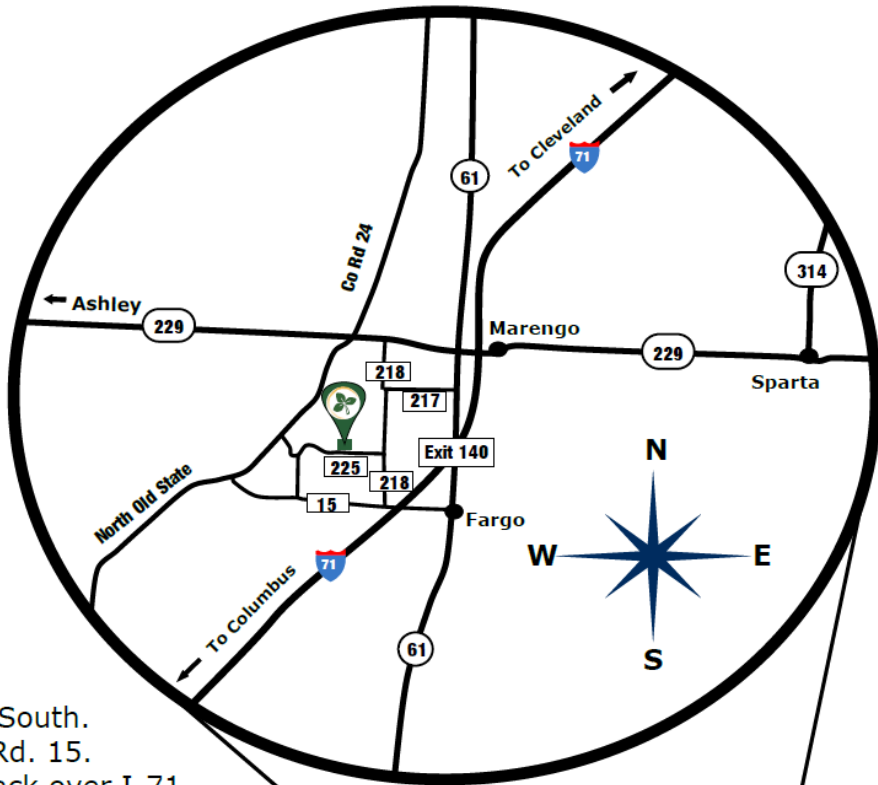

Driving Directions



From I-71

Take Exit 140, St. Rt. 61 South.
Turn right (west) on Co. Rd. 15.
County Road 15 will go back over I-71.
Turn right (north) on County Road 218. Turn
left (west) on County Road 225. The entrance
to Heartland is on the right.

From Route 23

Turn east on St. Rt. 229 and continue through
the town of Ashley. Turn right (south) on Co. Rd.
24, then left (east) on Co. Rd. 225.* The
entrance to Heartland is on the left.

***IMPORTANT: BUSES AND RVS CANNOT USE
Co. Rd. 24 to Co. Rd. 225 DUE TO LOAD LIMITS.
For Buses and RVs: Instead of turning right
(south) on Co. Rd. 24, continue to Co. Rd. 218
and then turn right (south). You will come to a
sharp left curve. After the curve, turn right to
stay on Co. Rd. 218. Go 1 mile and turn right
(west) on Co. Rd. 225. The entrance to Heartland
is on the right.**
