At Young Scholars Learning Center (YSLC), we are committed to fostering a safe, respectful, and productive learning environment for all students. This Code of Conduct outlines the expectations for student behavior and helps ensure a positive experience for everyone.

1. Respect and Courtesy:

- Treat all students, staff, volunteers, and visitors with respect and courtesy, regardless of age, race, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, ability, or background.
- Use respectful language and avoid any form of bullying, harassment, or discrimination (including verbal, physical, and cyberbullying).
- Respect the personal space and belongings of others.
- Listen attentively when others are speaking.
- Show appreciation for the efforts of staff and volunteers.

2. Responsibility and Integrity:

- Attend all scheduled classes and activities punctually and prepared.
- Complete all assignments and participate actively in learning activities.
- Be honest and truthful in all academic work. Plagiarism and cheating are strictly prohibited.
- Take responsibility for your own actions and their consequences.
- Respect YSLC property and the property of others.

3. Safety and Security:

- Follow all safety rules and procedures, including emergency evacuation and lockdown protocols.
- Report any safety concerns or suspicious activity to a staff member immediately.
- Refrain from bringing weapons, illegal substances, or other dangerous items to YSLC.
- Use electronic devices responsibly and in accordance with YSLC's technology policy.

- Adhere to all instructions given by staff members.

4. Appropriate Behavior:

- Maintain a positive and respectful attitude.
- Refrain from disruptive behavior that interferes with the learning environment.
- Use appropriate language and avoid profanity or offensive expressions.
- Follow the YSLC dress code.
- Keep the learning environment clean and organized.

5. Technology Use:

6. Consequences for Violations:

- Verbal warnings
- Written warnings
- Parent/guardian conferences
- Suspension from activities or the program
- Expulsion from YSLC

The severity of the consequence will depend on the nature and frequency of the violation. YSLC reserves the right to take immediate action in cases of serious misconduct.

7. Parent/Guardian Involvement:

- Parents/guardians are expected to support YSLC's Code of Conduct and work with staff to ensure their child's positive behavior.

- Parents/guardians will be notified of any behavioral issues and may be required to attend conferences.

8. Acknowledgment:

By enrolling in YSLC, students and parents/guardians agree to abide by this Code of Conduct.
