

# 2020 Club Championship Overview

**The Club Championship event has 4 groups of play:**

Players with 10 or more rounds played on Men's Day and Men's Club special events in the past 12 months are eligible to compete in Groups 1 – 3.

1. Championship Flight, Gross Match Play, Silver Tees, One signup form for all rounds. Signups close Sunday, April 19, 6PM. First round to be played Tuesday April 21. The 16 lowest index players who sign up will be in Group 1. April 15 indexes will be used. **\*Use only the Championship Flight sign up form to sign up.\***

If you sign up for the Championship Flight and do not make the top 16 cut by index, your name will be added to the Flighted play for April 22 and April 29. Once closed and you are in the Championship Flight you cannot change your status for this event. You are committed to pay the Championship Flight extra money even if you don't play.

2. Flighted Play, Gross & Net Stroke Play. Five flights. Silver and Bronze tees. Must sign up for each round. Signups close Monday, April 20, 6PM for the first round on Wednesday April 22, and Monday April 27, 6PM for the second round on Wednesday April 29.

3. 80+ Flight, men 80 years old and older, Gross & Net Stroke Play, Bronze tees. Must sign up for each round. Signups close Monday, April 20, 6PM for the first round on Wednesday April 22, and Monday April 27, 6PM for the second round on April 29.

4. Players that did not get in 10 rounds in Men's Club Events in the past 12 months are not eligible for the Championship but may play in a separate Gross & Net Stroke Play event. Must sign up for each round. Signups close Monday, April 20, 6PM for the first round on April 22 and Monday April 27, 6PM for the second round on April 29.

To Be in Groups 2, 3, & 4 -

Use normal sign up and cancel methods.

To win in groups 2, 3 & 4 you must play both days.

To be in group 3 you **must** make the Tournament Director (Tom Cox) aware of your age and intention to play in the 80+ flight.
