II. CONVENE MEETING: President Sommer opened the meeting at 1:45 p.m. There were 58 members present. The meeting began with a respectful tribute of silence for our Veterans.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: On a motion by Rich Lepke, seconded by Greg Simenthal, and by unanimous vote, the minutes of the October 14, 2020 general membership meeting were approved.

IV. APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT: Joe reviewed the Treasurer's report for the month of October, 2020. On a motion by Bill Linnemeyer and seconded by Steve Stewart, and by unanimous vote, the Treasurer's Report was approved. Joe estimates that we'll have about \$3,650 remaining heading into December. We can carry over \$2,000. We likely will have a lunch in December. The following 2021 deposits are set up with Revere: Member-Guest deposit of \$1K and 2021 Christmas Party for \$1K.

V. PRESIDENT'S COMMENTS: Scott Sommer commented as follows:

- Explained we are still awaiting HOA information on how much money we can carry over into 2021.
- Scott thanked Revere/Bill Klemke for donating range balls for both days of the member-member tournament and for adding 25% (over \$1,200!) to the Member-Member prize pool. Their generous donation led the RMGC Executive Board to unanimously agree to pay the prize pool in Revere Gift Cards.

Tournament Committee – (Chairman T. Cox). Please always meet at the carts prior to play. Today was a good example of why to do that - course changed. Calendar is set for next year. Club Championship will be in April; member-member in October. Tom announced the CTP winners for today's round.

Siena Ryder Cup Tournament Committee – Larry Lackaye will graciously continue to head up this tournament.

Member-Member Tournament Committee (Frank Tutera) - Frank presented money to the winning teams – and thanked Bill Klemke for the help that Revere provided.

Revere Report – Bill announced that Buckman's would have a "Thanksgiving-to-go"-dinner to feed 4-6 people for \$125 takeout. On December 7, Buckman's will present a new menu. Thanksgiving morning Revere will have a shotgun tournament; same thing on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. Course is working on the ball marks on the greens.
