II. CONVENE MEETING: President Paveza opened the meeting at 12:14pm. There were 42 members present.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: On a motion by Dave Harcourt, seconded by Dave Weil, April minutes were approved. Then those present unanimously approved.

Revere Report – (Bill Klemke) - Revere's been having difficulty in hiring people - there will be a lot of new people and a lot of training, so please be patient while new employees are on-boarded. Mother's Day brunch was sold out. Restroom on Lex 14/15 is nearing completion. It's getting warm enough to fertilize - which will occur within the next two weeks. Within a couple of weeks after fertilizing, one should notice a difference in the grass. There is some poah grass - especially on 9 and 18 on Lexington due to not watering for several weeks due to a water problem. Please do not take range balls home. If you have a situation where you don't hit your full bucket and have to depart, talk with someone in the shop and they will try to accommodate you. It will cost about \$4MM to redo the bunker, but that is not yet planned. Revere will be adding sand to the green-side bunkers. The irrigation system replacement will likely occur before redoing all of the bunkers. New golf carts are about 9 months from replacements - possibly with GPS, which would allow the course to "see" the pace of play. At that point, they may update the pace of play to get it to about 4 hours and 15 minutes. Annual passes are sold out for this year. Bill expects to open it back up at the beginning of next year. Currently, there are about 50 residents on the annual pass.
