II. CONVENE MEETING: President Paveza opened the meeting at 11:55pm. There were 59 members present.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: On a motion by Mike Keegan, seconded by Steve Stewart, minutes were approved. Then those present unanimously approved.

IV. APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT: Joe presented the July Financials. Motion to approve by Ed Shavitz and seconded by Randy Sotka.

V. PRESIDENT'S COMMENTS: Mike Paveza commented as follows:

- Mike presented gift cards for the Championship winners. If you were a Champion and not present, see Tom Cox before a Wednesday golf to pick up your gift card.

VI. COMMITTEE REPORTS:

**Tournament Committee** – (Chairman T. Cox). Tom presented CTPs. Also, Tom suggested that we read about the “local rules” regarding penalty areas and drop zones ([Rules \(godaddysites.com\)](http://Rules.godaddysites.com)). Drop Zones: there is NO drop zone on the left-side of the green on Concord #5. Drop zone for that hole is the Bronze tee - which is clearly spelled out on our website in the “local rules”-area. Also, a ball in the penalty area is to be dropped where the ball ENTERED the penalty area - not 90 degrees from where it was found.

**Handicap Committee** – (Mike Keegan). If we can't play to our normal handicap due to illness, talk w/ Chuck Frank or Mike Keegan. There is a way to remedy this so the “low handicap” doesn't get frozen.

**Membership-Social Committee** – (Chairman: G. Keith). Christmas party will be Monday, 12/6 at Revere. Gary is finalizing things with Revere.

**Home and Home Committee** – (Chairman: Bill Freitag) Canceled by Summerlin for 2021.

**Siena Ryder Cup Tournament Committee** – (Chairman: Larry Lackeye). No report.

**Member-Member Tournament Committee** (Chairman: Leroy Lalley). No report.

**Revere Report** – (Bill Klemke and Austin) - Lexington was planted with rye grass - and the extreme heat in June and the humidity and rain (3.5 inches of rain within 18 days at the golf course) caused some of the rye to die. Additionally there was some disease on Lexington. Anthem Country Club and Southern Hills have had similar problems. Unfortunately, there is a seed shortage - which Revere can't get until September 10 <Lexington start of over-see> until October 3 <Concord>. This is about 3.5 weeks behind normal. Lexington will not be over-seeded this year in the rough. It will likely be cart path only for approximately 10 days afterward. Usually, both golf courses are aerated; Sept 20-21 will be the Lexington aeration with 9 holes at a time and half the golf course closed. Also, will spray crab grass.

**Election Report** – (Scott Sommer) - There will be four spots open for election: secretary, tournament chair, handicap chair and social/membership chairman. See Scott if interested. So far, no one has stepped forward.
