Relief from abnormal course conditions

Rule for Concord Hole #10 adjoining the driving range

The driving range adjoining hole #10 does not have a barrier to prevent range balls from entering the fairway (hazardous condition) or balls from the fairway rolling on to the driving range.

Due to the radical slope of the fairway toward the driving range even the best drives down the middle may/will roll on to range or end up lost among hundreds of range balls in a settling area at the bottom right side of the fairway. This shall be deemed as an abnormal course condition.

If you are virtually certain that your drive has rolled on to the range or lost among the range balls, after a maximum 3 minute search, you may, without penalty, drop a ball and proceed to play. (Hitting 2).

Note: this only applies to the balls that "roll" out. <u>Drives that are sliced or hooked</u> directly on to the driving range are still considered as OB.

Handicap Committee- (Chairman M. Keegan). Chuck Frank in place of M. Keegan, Chuck kicked off the new "Ruby" tee box committee meeting. This effort was started by M. Keegan earlier this year. The committee agreed to work the Concord first to implement the new forward tee's, hope is to have these in place by end of June. More to come as progress is made.
