

REVERE MENS GOLF CLUB

MEMBER-MEMBER TOURNAMENT

General Information.

1. This is a two (2) round event.
2. Dates: Saturday October 31 on Lexington & Sunday November 1 on Concord. Lunch after play.
3. Format: 2- man best ball net. 100% of handicaps will be used.
4. There are no flights: 2-man teams will play against the field. No handicap restrictions – play with whomever you want. List your partner on the attached entry form.
5. Tee assignments: Play whichever tee you want. Indicate tee on the entry form. You may change your tee any time before the start of the first round. Must play the same tee in the second round.
6. Entry Fee: \$25 per man. A check must accompany the application for entry. 100% of the entry fee will go to the prize fund to be paid out in cash.
7. Green Fees: Players will pay the normal RMGC green fee each day. The normal \$5 entry prize money will be paid out as book credit with Revere.
8. For \$10, each player may purchase 1 mulligan per day. Must be purchased and paid for with the application for entry. All the mulligan money will go to the cash prize fund.
9. Magic Putts: For \$10 each, players may purchase 1 Magic Putt per day good for a “gimme” from anywhere on the green. Must be purchase and paid for with the application for entry. All Magic Putt money will go to the cash prize fund.
10. 40% of the prize money (20% each event day) will be paid to the top 5 places. 60% will be paid to the top 10 overall places.
11. Para Mutual Betting: The Pro Shop will run a para mutual paying 10 overall winners who have purchased bets. This is separate from the tournament prize money.

Rules of Play

USGA & RMGC Local Rules Apply except as modified below

1. Lift, clean and place in both fairway and rough. Balls in desert/rock penalty areas must be played as they lie. You may move loose impediments in the penalty area.
2. Balls in footprints or disturbed areas in a sand bunker may be moved to an area in the bunker that is not disturbed with no penalty. Loose impediments may be picked up.
3. Balls hit into a yellow marked (“water”) penalty area may be played from special marked drop zones for this event only.
4. Players will receive a ticket for Mulligans and Magic Putts. When played, the ticket must be handed to, and destroyed by, the scorer on the competitor team.
5. Mulligans may be used to replay any shot or any putt anywhere on the course.
6. Magic putts may be used anywhere on the green and must be declared and picked up without attempting the putt. Counts as one stroke.
7. Exchange Scorecards with your fellow competitor team.
