

My Score Card

- **Definitions:**
 - **Most Likely Score**
 - When hole is Not Completed or Stroke/hole Conceded use **Most Likely Score**
 - Number of strokes taken plus strokes to finish a hole more than half the time
 - A **Most Likely Score** should be preceded by a **X**
 - For posting, No limit to the number of unfinished holes in a round
 - **Equitable Stroke Control (ESC)** - the maximum Hole Score for posting
 - Based on Handicap for course & tee, applied after the round
 - This is not a maximum Hole Score for a Competition
- **Symbols to Use on Your Score Card for each Hole**
 - **Number** to indicate the gross **Number** of strokes for a hole, your score
 - **X Number** for a hole not completed, and **Number** is your **Most Likely Score**
 - **X Blank** for holes not played, or Not Played Under The Rules of Golf
 - **Blank** or **X Blank** are treated the same, **Blank** is ok when a player withdraws
 - Do not use + -, difference from Par, or any other non standard scoring system
- **Stroke Play**
 - For your score to count you must play your ball into the hole
 - Mark the **Number** of strokes on each hole, this is your gross score
 - If you pickup before your ball is in the hole, mark **X** and your **Most Likely Score**
 - You can not stop at your **ESC** limit unless you mark a **X** with the **Number**
 - Scoring the Competition
 - Any **Number** without a **X** will be used as your score
 - Any **X Number**, **X Blank**, or **Blank** score will be excluded from the Competition
 - You will be out of the competition for Individual Stroke play
 - Your hole score will be out of competition for other forms of stroke play
 - Some scoring systems will replace these with a 19 to exclude this score
- **Match Play**
 - Scores on the card are used for Posting only, scores may not indicate the winner
 - Mark your gross score for each hole
 - If a hole is conceded, mark **X** and your **Most Likely Score**
 - Scoring the Competition
 - The Match starts with your starting hole, the Match is over when player/side is ahead by more than the number of holes remaining (example: 3 up with 2 to go)
 - It is up to the players to indicate who won the Match (example: Joe won 3/2)
- **Score for posting, Stroke & Match** (The max number for a hole is your **ESC** limit)
 - Any **Number** without a **X** will be used as your score
 - For a **X Number** the **Number** is used as your score
 - For **X Blank** or **Blank**, Par + Hcp strokes are used as your score (Hole not played)
 - You must have played 13 or more holes for an 18 hole score to be posted
