At one time it was the home of Civil War veteran. He came to the area in the mid-1800s to recuperate from health issues. He had plans for a large brick house which was started but not finished, until Mr. Davis stepped in and finished the beautiful two-story home. There were many fruit trees of different varieties and huge poplars in front of the house. The home was eventually sold, and the new owner dreamed of converting the location into an amusement resort including a swimming pool and dancing pavilion. The property was eventually vacated, due to the owner having to leave the state, and for several years the grounds became overgrown. The estate had the appearance of a mysterious castle. In the early 1900's, the property was bought again, with the dreams of finishing the resort. Playground equipment and a dancing pavilion were installed in the early 1900's, but after ten years that dream was lost. The house was eventually razed due to its run-down and dangerous condition. with the dancing pavilion being torn down later. Maybe you will be able to find some of the old evidence from the estate or hear the music from the pavilion.
