

## NHTD/TBI Initial Service Plan (ISP) Process

## **Important Things to Note:**

- The NHTD/TBI Medicaid Waiver Program is a non-medical and non-emergency needs program.
- The NHTD/TBI Enrollment process is **very intensive** and has a lot of moving parts.
- The Regional Resource Development Center (RRDC) provides all NHTD/TBI Waiver Enrollment Approvals via the Initial Service Plan (ISP) submitted by A1 Service Coordination (A1SC).
- The NHTD/TBI Enrollment process typically takes **three (3) to six (6) months** without any barriers that could delay enrollment, such as MLTC enrollment, lack of medical records, missing documents, inability to secure providers, etc.
  - All barriers to timely enrollment will be reported to you and/or your designated representative by a member of the A1SC team immediately.
- The A1SC Team are **experts** in TBI/NHTD enrollment and make every effort possible to expedite this process.

## **Below is NHTD/TBI Enrollment Process:**

- 1. The Service Coordination Agency Selection (SCAS) form choosing A1 Service Coordination is signed by <u>you</u> and submitted to the Regional Resource Development Center (RRDC) by **you**.
- 2. The RRDC signs the SCAS giving A1SC permission to work with you.
  - Please note that A1SC cannot begin the ISP process without permission from the RRDC.
- 3. The A1SC Enrollment Team works with you to complete and submit the ISP to the RRDC within <u>60 days</u> of receiving the signed SCAS. During the 60-day timeframe:
  - You submit all supporting documents (see attached) to A1SC via email, fax, or mail.
  - You provide supporting medical records justifying the need for NHTD/TBI Waiver services to A1SC via email, fax, or mail <u>OR</u> A1SC will request from your medical provider with permission via the Authorization for Release of Health Information Pursuant to HIPAA form (see attached).
  - You choose your waiver provider/s and waiver service/s. AISC will provide help with securing waiver providers and services; however, the choice is yours.
  - A1SC writes all ISP documentation/forms required by the RRDC/DOH.
  - You review all ISP documentation/forms written by A1SC and provide permission to submit by signing where required.
- 4. A1SC submits your ISP to the RRDC for review within 60 days of SCAS approval.
  - (Please note that you will receive confirmation with a copy of the ISP via email/mail)
- 5. The RRDS reviews the ISP within **14 days** of submission.
  - A1SC will continue to follow-up with the RRDC to inquire about the status of the review/approval and provide updates to you via email/phone. Any concerns regarding the delay should be directed by you to the RRDC.
  - The ISP will either be approved **or** the RRDS will send corrections/revisions to A1SC.
- 6. If the RRDS sends corrections, A1SC has 7 days to return the requested corrections to the RRDS.
- 7. The RRDC will review the ISP revisions/corrections within 7 days of the submission.
  - Please note that A1SC makes every effort possible to provide the requested corrections/revisions to the RRDC in
    One (1) submission to avoid a back-and-forth revision cycle.
- 8. The RRDC will provide the Notice of Decision (NOD) approving NHTD/TBI Waiver enrollment to A1SC.
  - Enrollments for applicants enrolled on Managed Long-Term Care (MLTC) Medicaid is the 1st of the month.
  - Enrollments for applicants <u>not</u> enrolled on a MLTC Medicaid can be **any day of the month.** The effective date will be coordinated by A1SC with you and your Waiver Service Providers.
- 9. A1SC will inform you and your Waiver Team of the Approval by providing a copy of the approved Initial Service Plan including the Notice of Decision for NHTD/TBI Waiver Enrollment.
- 10. A1SC will schedule a meeting for you with the A1SC On-Going Service Coordination team to discuss your needs, goals, waiver services, etc. and prepare you for NHTD/TBI Waiver Enrollment.
