



## Managed Long-Term Care (MLTC) Medicaid Plans & NHTD/TBI Waiver

### **Important Things to Note:**

- Managed Long-Term Care (MLTC) Medicaid plans are **not** compatible with the NHTD/TBI Waiver Program.
- MLTC disenrollment must occur prior to Waiver Enrollment.
  - **Please do not disenroll from your MLTC yet!**
- All services currently provided by the MLTC will **STOP** upon waiver enrollment, this includes home care, physicians, rehabilitation services, incontinence supplies, medical supplies, transportation, hospitalization coverage, skilled nursing coverage, etc.
  - If you are uncertain of the services currently provided by your MLTC, please reach out directly to your MLTC caseworker for that information. A member of the A1 Service Coordination team can help, if needed.
- MLTC Disenrollment must occur prior to the 15<sup>th</sup> of the current month.
  - MLTC services will remain in place until the last day of the current month.
- NHTD/TBI Waiver Enrollment will only occur on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the following month.
  - Approved NHTD/TBI Waiver Services will begin on the 1<sup>st</sup> of that month.
- MLTC Enrollment will typically delay your NHTD/TBI Waiver Enrollment an additional one to two months.
- AISC will assist you through the process, so all MLTC support remains in place until Waiver enrollment.

### **Who Requests Disenrollment:**

- Only the MLTC enrollee or their authorized representative can request disenrollment.

### **How to Request Disenrollment:**

- The Medicaid Management Long Term Care (MLTC) Consumer Disenrollment form is signed by the MLTC enrollee and/or their authorized representative and submitted to the MLTC along with the Notice of Decision authorizing NHTD/TBI Waiver enrollment by the Regional Resource Development Center (RRDC).
  - This form will be provided to you by a member of the A1 Service Coordination team and submitted with your Initial Service Plan (ISP) to the RRDC.

### **When to Request Disenrollment:**

- **Please do not disenroll from your MLTC yet!**
- The Medicaid Management Long Term Care (MLTC) Consumer Disenrollment form will be submitted to the RRDC with your Initial Service Plan.

### **When will the ISP be submitted to the RRDC by AISC:**

- AISC will submit the ISP within the necessary time-frame required by the RRDC, DOH, and the MLTC to secure enrollment
  - **Example time-frame:** To secure enrollment onto the waiver for June 1<sup>st</sup>, AISC will need to submit your ISP to the RRDC **6 to 8 weeks prior** to June 1<sup>st</sup>. We anticipate this will allow enough time for the RRDC to review the ISP submission and provide the NHTD/TBI Waiver Enrollment Approval. If, for any reason, the approval is not provided by the RRDC by **May 15<sup>th</sup>**, NHTD/TBI Waiver Enrollment Approval will be delayed until July 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Please note that the RRDC provides all NHTD/TBI Waiver Enrollment Approvals. AISC makes every effort possible to secure NHTD/TBI Waiver Enrollment in a timely manner. All barriers to timely enrollment will be reported to you and/or your designated representative by a member of the AISC team immediately.**

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
