lota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc. is a national service fraternity that continues to remain true to the original purpose envisioned by its twelve founders. That purpose being "the development and perpetuation of scholarship, leadership, citizenship, fidelity and brotherhood among men." Founded on September 19, 1963, the fraternity today consists of over 325 undergraduate and alumni chapters with approximately 50,000 members in 38 states and the District of Columbia, Japan, the Republic of Korea, and Quidbo, Choco Colombia. The fraternity colors are Charcoal Brown and Gilded Gold.

Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc. is one of the 'Divine 9' National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC) member organizations. Iota was inducted into the NPHC in February 1997, joining the original Black Greek-letter organizations that were the 'Elite 8.' While the fraternity's membership is primarily African-American, membership is not restricted by race, creed, or national origin. The fraternity is also a member of the North American Interfraternity Conference, an international organization of over 60 national fraternities with a combined membership of over six million individuals.

From its inception, lota has recognized the need for strong leadership at every level of the fraternity. The national governing body is the Grand Council, consisting of the International Grand Polaris, the International Grand Vice Polaris, the International 2nd Grand Vice Polaris, the International Grand Treasurer and the International Grand Secretary. Grand Council members also include the fraternity's intermediate officers, the Director of Undergraduate Affairs, Director of Graduate Affairs, Director of Marketing, Director of Regional Affairs, Director of Community Impact, Director of Communications, Director of Technology, Director of Intake, Director of Training and Development, Director of Recruitment, Director of Military Affairs, National Chaplain, General Counsel and the fraternity's Executive Director.

Through our history and across the nation, lota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc. has come to represent excellence in all of our endeavors. We are and shall remain, dedicated to our founders' motto "Building a Tradition, Not Resting Upon One." It takes a Man!

OUR SERVICE INITIATIVES

As lota has grown, it has endeavored to maintain a standard of excellence and leadership on campus and in the community. In 1992, the fraternity established the National lota Foundation, a Tax-Exempt entity whose purpose is to assist the needy through scholarships and other financial assistance.
