Varietal: 90% Cabernet

Sauvignon, 5% Malbec, 3% Petite

Verdot, 2% Cabernet Franc

Acid: .6g/100ml

Vineyards & Winemaking:

The 2021 vintage was sourced from Estrella District vineyards in the Paso Robles AVA. The wine was fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks and went through a secondary malolactic fermentation. It was then aged for 18 months in American and Hungarian oak barrels.

Tasting notes:

Roasted black cherry, fig, caramel, and milk chocolate on the nose lend to flavors of dark cherry, raspberry, roasted plum, and fig.

Food pairing:

Enjoy Two Vessels Cabernet Sauvignon with roast meats, hearty stews, pasta Bolognese, and anything with grill marks.
