Per Florida law, a parent is to submit an annual evaluation to the school district superintendent once a year.

Per the FL DOE's Home Education FAQ, the anniversary of the Letter of Intent sets the evaluation deadline every year.

An evaluation is also due within 30 days of sending a Letter of Termination to end a home education program.

The parent of the above student is, according to Florida Statute FS 1002.41, hereby informing the Superintendent that this student has been evaluated by a Florida certified teacher holding a valid regular (professional) Florida certificate to teach academic subjects at the elementary or secondary level. Evaluation documentation is to be submitted by the parent and is typically sent to the Home Education Contact in the district.
