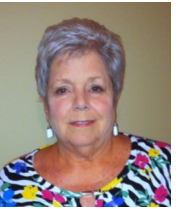

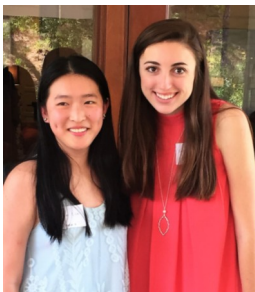

named for a former HSC member, who during her lifetime exemplified the definition of Community Service through her countless hours of voluntary service at multiple sites in Hoover and Birmingham.

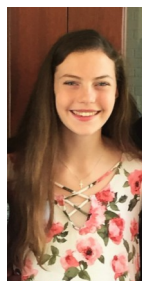
