# The History & Importance of Our 501(c)(3) Status

The Hoover Service Club was organized on May 5, 1075 by Mrs. Flora Mae Pike at age 82 with 10 ladies present and the motto of "helping others". For years the club served the community with a few dollars, then a few hundred dollars and grew to a few thousand dollars. We knew we wanted to be able to provide more for the community, and in order to do this we needed to seek 501(c)(3) tax exempt status. This would allow us to include the business community and be able to accept larger donations in raising funds for the community needs and scholarships.

In order to apply for a 501(c)(3), the Hoover Service Club needed to incorporate. With the help of a very generous attorney, the club became Hoover Service Club, Inc. in December 2003.

Immediately following our incorporation, Karen Sturgeon and Lois Taylor began the arduous process of obtaining our 501(c)(3) status. They traced back required documentation to the origin of the organization, signed many legal documents for the IRS, then submitted this information to the tax attorney in Montgomery. The attorney spent many man hours preparing and submitting this information to the IRS, while forgiving his fees in respect for what our organization did for the community. After 3 long years the Hoover Service Club, Inc. was granted approval by the IRS on February 11, 2006.
