### **Examining the Public Impact of Fluoride**

Almost half the world's population is affected by dental caries (cavities), making it the most prevalent of all health conditions. High levels of dental caries occur in middle-income countries where sugar consumption is high.

Adding fluoride to tap water in North America was one of the greatest public health accomplishments in the last century to help combat the onset of dental caries. Nonetheless, there is not much data within the last thirty years assessing the effect of this policy on the population's dental health.

Research carried out recently and published in the Dental Research Journal, entitled 'Water Fluoridation & Tooth Decay in Teenagers & Children,' analyzed links between tooth decay and public water fluoridation. Most specifically, the study looked at the effects of fluoride in adolescents and children.

During this study, the data indicated that teenagers and children with better access to water fluoridation were less prone to tooth decay. Countries with governments that made water fluoridation accessible to more than three quarters of their citizens, experienced a 30% decline in tooth decay in the primary dentition (baby teeth), and a 12% decline in the lasting dentition (adult teeth).

These results reflect data from the previous 50 years, and indicate that water fluoridation still provides a significant benefit to dental health, for teenagers and children. The present study adds to the data - by proving that the advantage is most noticeable early in a child's life, those between two and eight years old.

The City of Winnipeg has been adding fluoride to the municipal water system since 1956. Families living in rural municipalities, such as West St. Paul however, are predominately reliant on well water which does not contain fluoride. Luckily there are many other ways to incorporate the benefits of fluoride in our everyday oral health routines.

The simplest way is to use a toothpaste that contains fluoride. There are also fluoride rinses, varnishes, gels and trays that can be easily administered by a dental



He and Tracy have a tremendous amount of respect for one another.



### **Hockey Fun Facts**

Ice hockey may be considered one of the most popular sports in North America. Here are a couple fun facts you might not know about it!

- 1. Early hockey games allowed as many as 30 players a side. There was a stone frozen into the ice at each end which represented the goals.
- 2. It has been recorded that the very first hockey pucks were actually made of cow dung.
- 3. The first recorded indoor ice hockey game took place in Montreal's Victoria Skating Rink in 1875.
- 4. Frederick Arthur, Lord Stanley of Preston, is responsible for what is now known as the Stanley Cup. In 1893, the Canadian governor-general donated the cup to be given annually to the top Canadian team.
- 5. The Montréal Canadiens currently hold the record for most Stanley Cup Championships at 24 times won!
- 6. Women's ice hockey made its Winter Olympic Games debut as a sport in Nagano in 1998.
- 7. There are rules regarding the length of a hockey stick. There is a specific rule that states that no stick shall exceed 65 inches in length!

- 8. NHL teams actually have a list of emergency goalies that aren't on the roster but attend all home games in the stands. Scott Foster filled in as an emergency goalie for the Chicago Blackhawks in the 2017-2018 season and helped secure the victory against the Winnipeg Jets.
- 9. Many organizations and teams keep game pucks in a bucket of ice or in the freezer. It sounds weird, but it keeps them from bouncing all over the place.

### Valentine's Day DIY Garland By Lexi Breunig

#### What you'll need:

- Felt (in various colours like pink, red, and white)
- Thread
- Needle
- Stuffing
- Scissors

#### **Directions:**

- 1. To begin, double up two sheets of the same colour of felt so that there is one piece on top of another. Then, cut out the heart shapes. Feel free to experiment with different sizes and types of hearts.
- 2. Using a whip stitch technique, begin sewing the front and back of the heart together. If you're unsure how to do a whip stitch, a quick Google search will be helpful. Before the front and back are completely sewn shut, add the stuffing in.



- 3. When you're done stuffing the heart, you can finish the heart by sewing it shut. Tie the end of the thread a few times to make sure it doesn't come undone.
- 4. Repeat steps 2-3 with all of your hearts until you have enough hearts for your desired length of garland.
- 5. Use a long piece of thread to string assemble the garland. I threaded my needle through the tops of the stitches on each heart, but you can also thread them together on the back of each heart.
- 6. Tie a knot on each end of the thread, so that each end has loops for hanging.
- 7. Hang the completed garland on your fireplace, a shelf, or anywhere that needs a colourful touch.







### Recipe

### **Easy Chicken Pot Pie**

#### Crust

Combine and cut in the following ingredients with a pastry blender until crumbled.

- 2/3 cup butter-flavour shortening
- 1 3/4 cups flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 cups grated cheese

Add 7-9 tablespoons of ice water. Using your hands, knead until dough forms a ball. Divide the dough in half and place half the dough between wax paper. Roll it out, then

roll out the second half using the same method. Keep the dough in the wax paper and refrigerate while you prepare the filling.

#### Filling:

2 or 3 chicken breasts, fully cooked in a crockpot. I sprinkle chicken breasts with 2 tablespoons of chicken bouillon and some minced fresh onion, then cover with water and cook. You will want to cook the chicken ahead of time. Add cooked chicken to the following ingredients.

- 2 cans mixed vegetables, drained and rinsed
- 1 cup frozen peas, rinsed
- 1 can cream of potato soup
- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 1/4 teaspoon rosemary
- 1/4 teaspoon thyme

Add milk or cream to the mixture to make it creamy but not runny.

To assemble, line the bottom and sides of a pie dish with dough, removing the wax paper. Poke holes in the bottom crust using a fork. Pour in the filling and place the second pie crust on the top. Pinch the crust together and cut vent holes in the top. Beat an egg, mix it with a little water, and brush over the top of the pie crust, sprinkling with coarse salt.

Bake at 350 for 1 hour or until the crust is golden brown.




