Tennis court the fence has heaved even more raising the posts out of the ground and are now splitting more. The fabric because of this is coming off — the posts and curling. The concrete deck has trip hazards and now is cracking off every post. The inspection on the ballfield backstop will come back to me in an estimate because it is all bad. Home plate also needs to be replaced.

June Jordening presented her account receivable report to the Board.

Accountant Gary Shepherd provided his report.

The proposal from Clean Sweep Commercial Inc., was approved and the sweepers to come out ASAP.
