DAY 3 Accra / koforidua / Kroboland - Travel Day

Asenema waterfalls nestle in the forest of Adukrom. Visit kroboland to witness the the process of the art of beads making. We continue to Koforidua for overnight.

DAY 4 Koforidua - Kumasi - Travel Day

We leave koforidua early for lunch in Kumasi. Explore the neighborhood. Welcome performance from the Ashanti Region.

DAY 5 Kumasi City tour

Visit the Manyiah Palace Museum of the Asantehene to see rare royal regalia and effigies of past Ashanti kings. Visit Prempeh the ll Museum where you can see the fake golden stool given to the Brittish.

DAY 6 Kumasi - Craft Villages

Visit the craft villages of Bonwire for Kente weaving and learn the art of weaving of the famous Ghanaian cloth. Visit Ntonso for Adinkra cloth where we learn about how they get the natural black color for the cloth and ink. Learn the meaning and origin of the various Adinkra symbols. Print your own Adinkra Kente cloth. Visit the Ahwiaa wood carvings village and see carvers at work carving the intricate stools made for the chiefs and queens.

DAY 7 Kumasi - Cape coast - Travel Day

Leave Kumasi for Cape coast where our heritage tour into African enslavement begins at Assin Manso slave river site. During the guided tour you will learn about the largest slave market in the south where the captives had their last bath and first branding. Welcome Dinner in Cape Coast at One Africa or Mabel's Table. Evening presentation by the Healing House on healing and traditional spirituality. Traditional drum and dance performance during dinner.

DAY 8 DAY Cape Coast / Elmina Dungeons

(Wearing white is suggested) Visit the enslaved dungeons built by the Portuguese in the 1400's. Lunch at the Cape Coast Coffee House (Owned by Oakland Local, Jeff Saunders). End the day with a naming ceremony in the village of Iture. Group Dinner at hotel catered by Ms. Mercy.

DAY 9 Cape Coast / Kakum Park

At Kakum National Park you may walk on the canopy walkway or hike through the forest to learn about the economic and cultural values of the trees and plants. Try the excellent local palm wine sold at the park entrance! Learn how to prepare a local meal for dinner in Elmina Ewe village in the late afternoon. Optional Cape Coast "Night Out/Bar Crawl".

DAY 10 Cape Coast

Pack, then spend the day by the beach and mingle with the local fishermen. Catered dinner at Kofi Tabb's Place.
