Hearts 4 Heroes USA is a non-profit organization dedicated to supporting fire service members, to help them better do their jobs. The Organization has generously donated a service dog (Captain Charley) to our Department, to provide support and comfort to our staff and community. Captain Charley is a five month old Labradoodle assigned to Firefighter Heide Glockner. The backup handler is Support



Group member, Pat Johnson. The program provides all expenses for the dog, including handler training, food, supplies, equipment, vet care. The focus of the program is PTSD reduction and mitigation among responders and others suffering trauma from major incidents. There is no cost to the District. Hea<u>http://www.software995.com/</u>rts 4 Heroes has recently provided service dogs to the Garden Valley, Folsom and Rescue FDs.

Support Group has conducted two training sessions to re-open Mosquito Road in the event of an evacuation order. We feel confident that Support Group designated members can quickly access the gated construction area and contact Shimmick Construction workers to determine when the road and existing bridge can be accessed by responding Sheriff's deputies and residents leaving the area. Access and communications were tested and discussed among the responding members. The road is scheduled to reopen on August 6th. Thank you to Taffy Warner and Mary Williams for their Station Manager coordination and testing our procedures, giving us confidence that we can get the road open and residents out quickly.

Congratulations to Firefighter Austin Eby who just completed his National Registration Exam and is officially an Emergency Medical Technician. Austin is a community-based volunteer and will make contributions to the Department and Community for years to come. Heide Glockner passed her EMT academy and will take the Nation Reg test soon. We are proud of Austin and Heidi and appreciative of what they will each give back to the Community. OES 4312 is being sent to the repair shop for problems with the pump. The truck was delivered to Sacramento OES fleet yard on Thursday, June 22nd. There will not be a replacement and we will not see the engine for several months.

Fire Season 2023 is upon us. As the weather improves, increased caution must be taken with outside burning. Please refrain from open burning and only cut weeds/grass/vegetation in the cooler morning hours before noon and never when it is windy.

Remember to practice evacuation procedures and always be aware of two escape routes. It's easy to get cut off during an actual incident.

Below is a list of important dates. Training returns to Tuesday nights at 6:00pm. The public is invited to come, observe training and meet our personnel.

Our Fire District staff is fully committed to our Community. We stand ready to assist our residents with any needs they may have, to prepare, support and provide the most up to date information. 


