- 3.) The temperatures during the time period were 26-28 degrees. This would make detailing a car, inside and out, next to impossible without the water changing to ice when freezing is 32 degrees. The idea that anyone would even attempt this is ludicrous!
- Read any of the product labels and they will tell you not to expose them to extreme heat or cold as it renders the products useless.
- 5.) To try and wash spots from cloth interiors in frigid weather would only cause the spot to get much larger, not come clean. Not only would the seats never dry, the carpet would remain wet, causing extreme humidity and eventually get moldy.
