- mother fearful about the possibility of a miscarriage

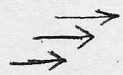

Adjustment/Behavioral Health



- projects blame on others/denies responsibility for actions
- no sense of guilt
- little respect for authority
- limited social interaction with peers
- respondent disapproves of Anne's friends
- illegal activity, but no court referral
- inappropriate or illegal activity has included:
 - shoplifting
 - marijuana use
 - use of multiple drugs
 - theft
 - significant dishonesty/lying
- is often lost in thoughts
- suffers from boredom
- lacks self-confidence
- poor memory/often forgets



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
