Tour Itinerary

Day 0: Friday, June 12 — Travel Day

Depart from your home airport for your flight to London. Or consider arriving a day or two early to settle in and adjust to the time difference. We are happy to help arrange customized pre-tour options and extensions.

Day 1: Saturday, June 13 — Our Tour Begins

Upon arrival at London Heathrow Airport you will be met for transfer to your hotel in Windsor. The remainder of the day is at your leisure to enjoy Windsor at your own pace. If you'd like we can suggest activities or arrange advance tickets to Windsor Castle (subject to your arrival time). A tour manager will be on hand to assist with check-in, offer recommendations and answer any questions. Day 2: Sunday, June 14 — Devon

After breakfast, we'll board a deluxe motor coach and begin our journey southwest to delightful Devonshire. Along the way, we'll stop to explore Stourhead House & Gardens before continuing on to Sidmouth, the setting of Julie's *On Devonshire Shores* series. This evening enjoy a special program with Julie and a local history expert. *Overnight in Sidmouth*

Day 3: Monday, June 15 — Devon and Dorset

We start our day with a guided walking tour of Sidmouth and a visit to the Sidmouth Museum. The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure — a stroll along the beach, browse the local shops, or sample some of the town's charming cafés and restaurants.

Day 4: Tuesday, June 16 — Agatha Christie, the Mayflower, and Cornwall

Today we'll discover the stunning coastline and sights that inspired Julie's novel, *A Castaway in Cornwall*. You'll also have time to enjoy the beaches, browse local shops, or enjoy a bite in a nearby restaurant or café. How about a Cornish pasty or cream tea?

Overnight in Newquay

Day 6: Thursday, June 18 — Exeter Cathedral and onto Bath

Today we travel into Somerset, with a stop enroute to see the stunning Exeter Cathedral. From there we continue to the elegant Georgian city of Bath. Enjoy a guided walking tour to get acquainted with Bath's charming streets and begin planning how you'd like to spend your free day tomorrow.

Day 7: Friday, June 19 — Full Day in Bath

Today is yours to discover all that Bath has to offer! Visit Bath Abbey, admire the grand Royal Crescent, unwind at the Thermae Bath Spa – soaking in the same mineral-rich waters that made the city famous over 2,000 years ago. You might like to take in a show at the Theatre Royal, explore the Jane Austen Centre, or treat yourself to a classic Sally Lunn Bun. Plus, there are parks, shops, bookstores, and scenic walks to enjoy!

Overnight in Bath

Day 8: Saturday, June 20 — The Charming Cotswolds

Today we'll drive into the enchanting Cotswolds, a region known for its thatched cottages, rolling green hills, and grazing sheep. Enjoy some free time to explore a charming English Village – browse local shops and dine at a cozy pub or restaurant of your choice. Later, we will visit Painswick, affectionately known as 'The Queen of the Cotswolds,' for a guided walk-through scenic lanes and the historic churchyard - featured in *Whispers at Painswick Court*, coming in December 2025.

Overnight in the Cotswolds

Day 9: Sunday, June 21 — Stately Home and Living History

This morning, we will set out on a day trip to Attingham Park, an elegant 18th-century estate featuring grand Regency-era interiors as well as restored servant quarters and kitchen. We'll also visit the lively Blists Hill Victorian Town, where history comes to life through recreated shops, cottages and craftspeople demonstrating traditional trades. We will return to the hotel this evening for our final group dinner.

Overnight in the Cotswolds

Day 10: Monday, June 22— Cotswolds and Blenheim Palace

We'll start the day with a visit to another delightful Cotswolds village, where you will have time to explore, shop, or enjoy lunch at your leisure. Then it's on to magnificent Blenheim Palace, the birthplace and ancestral home of Sir Winston Churchill. We will wrap up our day and our touring time together at our Heathrow airport hotel with a relaxed evening and time to pack for the journey home.

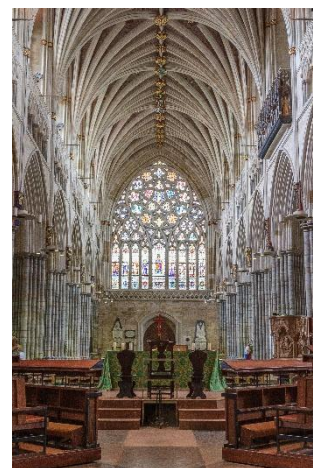
