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Planned Day by Day itinerary

This itinerary could be influenced by weather and sea conditions. Adjustments will be made as needed with the best interest of the tour group in mind. This is an abbreviated itinerary. Complete details will be provided closer to departure.

August 30th – Departure

August 31st – Flight arrivals and free day in Inverness Join tour group this evening for a welcome drink

September 1st – Inverness – Enjoy a full day to explore all that Inverness has to offer. Optional day trips can be arranged (B)

September 2nd – Inverness to Portree depart Inverness today and head to Elgol on Skye, enjoy a boat trip to Loch Coruisk, then make way to Portree for overnight. (B)

September 3rd – Portree to Pollochar visit Dunvegan Castle & Gardens, ferry to North Uist, and on to the Pollochar Inn our home for the next 3 nights (B,D)

September 4th – Eriskay and Barra, visit Kisimul Castle, walks around Castlebay, possible visit to iron-age fort Dun Scurrival, return to Pollochar Inn for dinner and leisurely evening (B,D)

September 5th – North & South Uist possible sites include Balranald Visitor Centre, the ancient church Teampall na Trionaid, Borge Castle, Temple of St. Mary, and Our Lady of the Isles Statue. Overnight at the Pollochar Inn (B,D)

September 6th – Pollochar to Tulloch Castle departing Pollochar towards the mainland. Visit to Langass Barp Chambered Cairn, travel across Skye with photo stops, ending our day at our Castle Hotel for the next 2 nights. (B,D)

September 7th – Free day at Tulloch Castle or Day trip to Tarbet Discovery Center & The Black Isle. (B,D)

September 8th – Culloden Battlefield & Clava Cairns visit the ancient stones of Clava Cairns and walk the solemn grounds of Culloden – two powerful sites that connect Scotland's turbulent past with its prehistoric roots. We end our day at our hotel next door to the Inverness airport where you can relax, pack and enjoy dinner on your own (B)

September 9th – Transfer to Inverness airport for flights home.



Highlights: Small group – maximum of 12 participants! The enchanting Outer Hebrides - leave the hectic pace of day-to-day life behind and get away from it all. The scenery is profound; with pristine white sand beaches, beautiful blue waters, ever changing landscapes, and ages of deep history. All lodging will be 3-4 star Scottish Tourist Board approved hotels, inns, guesthouses or B&B's. Your property assignment will be advised at time of travel document distribution 30 days prior to departure

All lodging will have private bathroom (not guaranteed to be in room) with shower only. Bathtubs are limited. Wi-Fi is limited in many areas of the highlands as well as in some areas of hotels.

If you are traveling solo and would like to be paired with a same gender roommate let us know and we will try to match you. Air from your home departure airport is available. Please ask for a quotation. \$500 tour deposit is due at the time of booking. Final payment date: May 29th, 2026. Once confirmed cancellation/change penalties will apply. Land cancellation penalties: nonrefundable deposit. May 29th 42– July 31st = 50% cancellation penalty. August 1st – August 15th = 75% cancellation penalty. August 16th - departure = nonrefundable. Travel insurance is optional and additional but highly recommended. Ask your agent for details. Organizers reserve the right to modify itinerary if necessary.
