JUNE 1ST – JUNE 7TH 2025

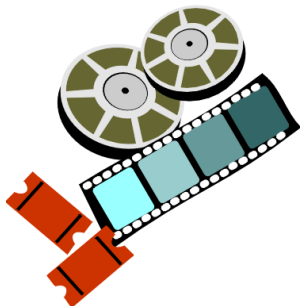
At long last, a Hollywood tour dedicated to honoring the legends who've entertained us over the years, with visits to iconic locations where it all took place!

During your tour, you'll be chauffeured to seven major cemeteries around the L.A. area and dine at famous spots where stars still gather. You'll pass by studios like Sony Pictures and the Culver Studios and explore what was once the 40-acre backlot where classic TV shows like *The Andy Griffith Show*, *Gomer Pyle*, and *Hogan's Heroes* were filmed. You'll also catch glimpses of past star homes and other landmarks that have shaped L.A.'s fame. This intimate small group tour will take you through Hollywood, the Hollywood Hills, Beverly Hills, canyon roads, parts of the valley and more!

DAY BY DAY HIGHLIGHTS

June 1st: Arrive in LA and check into the hotel for some relaxation.

June 2nd: Start the day at 8:30 am with a visit to Hillside Cemetery. Afterward, we'll head to The Farmers Market for lunch, passing through Culver City where you'll spot Sony and Culver Studios. Culver City is also home to the historic Culver Hotel, where Laurel and Hardy filmed many of their movies. We'll continue through the former 40-acre backlot, where numerous classic TV shows were filmed. After lunch, we'll view the La Brea Tar Pits and other sights as we make our way to Pierce Brothers Westwood Village. After the tour, we'll return to the hotel for some rest before heading to Dan Tana's for dinner to end the day.

June 3rd: Our first stop today will be Hollywood Forever Cemetery, followed by some sightseeing as we make our way to the famous Pink's Hot Dogs for lunch. Next, we'll see the homes of old Hollywood stars while driving through Beverly Hills. We'll stop by Roxbury Drive, where iconic figures like Lucy and Desi Arnaz, Jack Benny, and Peter Falk once lived. Our final stop will be Holy Cross Cemetery. We'll conclude the day with dinner at Cantor's Deli (be sure to try the excellent pastrami!).

June 4th: Enjoy the morning on Hollywood Blvd, exploring at your own pace. You can see the handprints and footprints at the Chinese Theater, stroll along the Hollywood Walk of Fame, and find your favorite celebrity's star. Visit Ripley's Believe It or Not or the Hollywood Museum or check out Madame Tussauds and the Hollywood Wax Museum. Grab a bite to eat at your leisure before heading up to Griffith Observatory for stunning views of the city. Then we will do a little sightseeing and if you're feeling up to it, you can climb the Music Box Steps where Laurel and Hardy filmed one of their famous short films "The Music Box". Afterward, we'll make our way to the Rainbow Bar and Grill, a historic spot filled with rock 'n' roll history for dinner. We'll return to the hotel earlier tonight so you can relax.

June 5th: Start the day at Forest Lawn Glendale. Afterward, we'll grab lunch at In-N-Out Burger and then make our way over to Warner Brothers for a Studio tour. Dinner tonight is at the famous El Coyote restaurant, featured in *Once Upon a Time in Hollywood*. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel.

June 6th: Enjoy a slightly later breakfast at Mel's Diner on Sunset Blvd., formerly Ben Frank's, a favorite hangout for musicians and where The Monkees were formed. We'll drive up a canyon road to visit locations where shows like *Gilligan's Island* and *The Brady Bunch* were filmed and see the iconic Brady House. Our final cemetery visits will be at Mount Sinai and the largest cemetery on the tour, Forest Lawn Hollywood. After a walk through Forest Lawn, we'll head to the Original Bob's Big Boy for a satisfying meal. On Fridays, they host a car show from 4-10 pm, and sometimes Jay Leno makes an appearance! Maybe we will get lucky! After dinner, we'll return to the hotel.

June 7th: Departure day with transfer to the airport.
