#### **Planned Day by Day Itinerary**

April 24<sup>th</sup> – Departure from home airport – overnight flight to Scotland

**April 25**<sup>th</sup> – **Arrival Inverness** - transfer to our city center hotel. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure for you to explore the city, take a stroll along the River Ness, visit the Inverness Museum and Art Gallery to explore the collections about Highland life and culture or maybe you want to visit Scotland's largest secondhand bookstore, Leakey's. Join our tour group this evening for a welcome dinner at the hotel. (D)

**April 26**<sup>th</sup> – **Inverness** - the majority of the day is for you to enjoy all that Inverness has to offer. Late afternoon we transfer as a group out to Dingwall, just north of Inverness, for our stay at Tulloch Castle. We will dine together this evening in the hotel restaurant. (B,D) Optional excursions can be arranged to visit Culloden Battlefield, Clava Cairns or do a Loch Ness cruise.

**April 27**<sup>th</sup> – **Tulloch Castle** - **day at leisure** Enjoy a full day for reading, relaxing, walking, playing games, exploring the castle or catching up on sleep. Optional local tours or transfers to Inverness will be available. Enjoy dinner on your own this evening in our hotel. (B,D)

April 28<sup>th</sup> – Tulloch Castle to Thurso. We set off on our road adventure today! Highlights include a visit to Dunrobin Castle, the home to the Earls and Dukes of Sutherland since the 1300s and wandering among the 200 mysterious stones at Hill O'Many Stanes. We end our day in the harbor town of Thurso where we will have time to find our evening meals on our own. (B)

**April 29**<sup>th</sup> – **Thurso to Thurso.** Our day trip from Thurso will include seeing the ruins of Castle Sinclair and time for a photo with the world-famous Journey's End sign at John O'Groats. We will return to our hotel in Thurso by late afternoon where you will be free to explore for a bit and dine on your own again this evening. (B)

April 30<sup>th</sup> – Thurso to Lochinver This morning we continue our 500-mile journey heading west across the top of Scotland. We visit the impressive Strathnaver museum to learn about life in the area and the brutal Highland Clearances. We will take a walk down to mythical, and sometimes eerie, Smoo Cave, one of the largest sea caves in Britain. We then stop for lunch and a bit of shopping for local made wares in Durness before we continue our roadtrip and end our day in the harbor town of Lochinver. You can enjoy dinner at the hotel or opt for a stroll around town to find your meal. (B)

May 1<sup>st</sup> – Lochinver to Ullapool Today will be a day full of scenic drives! For those with geological interests it's also a day to explore the fascinating natural wonders of the area with a visit to Knockan Crag Nature Reserve where you can look at the mystery of how old rock can sit on top of much younger rock! Trust us when we say that even non rockhounds will enjoy this visit! We end our day in charming Ullapool where you will have a bit of time to explore and find your evening meal. (B)

May 2<sup>nd</sup> – Ullapool to Applecross We begin our day with a visit to Inverewe Garden. See plants from around the world in this stunning sub-tropical garden located in the most unusual location, on a rocky peninsula in northwest Scotland! We continue our day which will include beautiful beaches, an Iron Age Fort, a waterfall, a Viking Parliament site and more! What a day it will be! We overnight at the secluded Hartfield House complex. (B)

May 3<sup>rd</sup> – Applecross to Inverness We start our day with a bit of adrenaline as we travel the Bealach na Ba Pass (Pass of the Cattle). The steepest road ascent in the UK! We continue around Loch Kishorn, take a little walk at Rogie Falls and then make our way into Inverness where we end our road trip adventure this evening with a farewell dinner together in our hotel before turning in early to pack for our journey home tomorrow. (B, D)

May 4<sup>th</sup> – Flights home Transfer to the Inverness airport for flights

It is recommended that guests dress in warm, layered clothing and wear flat, comfortable shoes. The order of sights visited may be altered or substitutions be made at the discretion of the tour, driver and guide. All lodging, except for one night, will have private bathroom (not guaranteed to be in room) with shower only. Bathtubs are limited. Wi-Fi is limited in many areas of the highlands as well as in some areas of hotels. Connectivity during this tour may be limited.

If you are traveling solo and would like to be paired with a same gender roommate let us know and we will try to match you. Air from your home departure airport is available. Please ask for a quotation. Nonrefundable \$500 tour deposit is due at the time of booking. Final payment due: March 1st, 2025. Once confirmed cancellation/change penalties will apply. Land cancellation penalties: nonrefundable deposit. March  $1^{st}$  - March  $24^{th}$  = 50% cancellation penalty. March  $24^{th}$  - April  $16^{th}$  = 75% cancellation penalty. April  $17^{th}$  - departure = nonrefundable. Travel insurance is optional and additional but highly recommended. Ask your agent for details.
