October 14th ~ Depart on your overnight flights to Inverness, dinner and a light breakfast will be served on board

October 15th ~ Transfer from Inverness airport to city center hotel. Rooms may not be available for check in upon arrival but the hotel will store your luggage while you go out and explore Inverness. Join your fellow travelers this evening for a welcome dinner in the hotel restaurant (D)

October 16th ~ We depart Inverness today with impressive, Ballindalloch Castle, Braemar Castle with it's star shaped curtain wall, and the Royal Lochnager Distillery on our itinerary before ending our day in Ballater (B) **October 17th** ~ Today we visit the ruins of Huntly Castle. The Strathisla Distillery, the charming seaside village of Portknockie and the Bow Fiddle Rock. We spend the evening in seaside Banff. (B)

October 18th ~ This morning we visit 11th century Dalgatie Castle, Georgian Duff House, the village of Pennan, Deer Abbey, and Aden Country Park before we make our way into Peterhead for the night. (B)

**October 19th** ~ The haunting ruins of Slain Castle start our day, followed by lunch at Dogtap at Brewdog Distillery, a visit to Castle Fraser and more today. Overnight in Aberdeen (B)

October 20th ~ Dunottar Castle, Corgarff Castle, and the Glenlivet Distillery fill our touring day before we end in Inverness this evening. (B)

October 21st  $\sim$  A day trip out of Inverness to the western Highlands before returning to our hotel for a farewell dinner (B,D)

October 22nd ~ Flights from Inverness airport home
