Dear Parishioners: In the first of a series of parables of the Word of God, Jesus speaks of a Sower who scatters seed on the ground. Sowers were common in Jesus’ day. A Sower casts seeds over the entire ground. The different results are brought about not by the seed itself or the care of the Sower, but by the quality of the ground. In the long form of the parable, Jesus explains that there are many things that can keep us from receiving the Word – ignorance, trouble, anxiety, and riches. But the one who receives the Word with joy as well as understanding will bear fruit in great abundance (Sourcebook).

The reading from Isaiah is a beautiful comparison between God’s Word and the action of the rain and snow on earth. The Word of God has a purpose. It transforms us and helps us to grow in God’s love and life. In what ways does the Word of God take root in us? In what ways can we become more receptive to God’s call?

As I write, we recently had a joy-filled parish pastoral council meeting, during which we welcomed five new members. I am grateful for our staff, councils, groups, and individuals who serve in our parish.
