Dear Parishioners: October is Respect Life Month, and we uphold the sanctity of human life in every stage. We celebrated the Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7th. Devotion to the rosary gives strength in our belief that Mary intercedes on our behalf. During our Tuesday evening rosaries, we have been praying for peace and for an end to war.

Sunday, October 19th is the collective feast day of the North American Martyrs. A nine-day Novena of prayers and intercessions will begin on October 11th and conclude on October 19th. A brief Novena prayer of the day will end each Mass.

I am part of the local Serra Club, members of whom gather to pray for and promote Church vocations. During your prayers, please ask the Holy Spirit to reveal the names of people who might become good priests, deacons, and religious sisters. We are already blessed with vocations from our local area.

The Solemnity of All Saints will take place on Saturday, November 1st. We honor the saints, known and unknown, who lived in God’s grace, and now live in God’s eternal kingdom. We are all called to become saints. Even with the Holy Day obligation being dropped this year, All Saints Day Masses will be Friday, October 31st at 6:30 pm and Saturday, November 1st at 8:00 am. Weekend Mass times are as usual. The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls), will take place on Sunday November 2nd. May our departed loved ones rest in God’s peace.

As Jesus traveled along the border between Galilee and Samaria, he healed ten lepers, only one of whom, a Samaritan, returned and gave thanks. The Samaritan’s gratitude is an expression of faith that brings salvation. This is a faith that yearns for healing from the Lord, while recognizing that healing is not a rightful possession, but a gift. Offer thanks to God daily.
