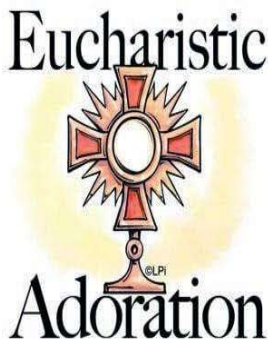

Dear Parishioners: This Sunday, we listen to Matthew's account of Jesus walking on the water. After the feeding of the multitude, Jesus went up a mountain to pray. As the disciples occupied a boat, the wind kicked up. They looked and saw Jesus approaching them on the water. Jesus said, "take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." Peter tells Jesus to call him, and Peter too walked on the waves. He began to sink, Jesus caught him, and the disciples recognized Jesus as the Son of God. Notice the parallels with the first reading. Like Jesus, Elijah climbed a mountain, after which signs of nature appear, and God was found in a gentle breeze.

August is the month of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The Assumption of Mary, a Holy Day, will be celebrated on Saturday, August 15th. There is no obligation this year, but we still schedule a Mass and invite all to take part. Mary has gone before us, body, and soul, into heaven. This gives us increased hope that Jesus is the way to heaven for us all. The Assumption Mass will take place on Saturday, August 15th at 9:00 am.

Another school year is approaching, and we are making preparations at Bishop Baraga Catholic School and in our Faith Formation programming. May God bless all of our students and their families.
