#### **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION DAY**

This single day each month is set aside for us, as a parish family, to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Mass is at 7:00 a.m. followed by Adoration all day with Benediction at 4:50 p.m. CONFESSIONS; from 6:30 to 6:50 a.m. and on the hour throughout the day till 4:30 p.m. It is our prayer that every family will participate in this most important day!!!

**HOLY COMMUNION; OUR LIFE IN CHRIST** The Sacrament of Holy Communion is the third of the <u>Sacraments</u> of Initiation. Even though we are required to receive Communion at least once per year (our <u>Easter Duty</u>), and the Church urges us to receive Communion frequently (even daily, if possible), it is called a sacrament of initiation because, like <u>Baptism</u> and <u>Confirmation</u>, it brings us into the fullness of our life in Christ. In Holy Communion, we are eating the True Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, without which "you shall not have life in you" (John 6:53). In order to receive Communion, we must be in a state of grace and we must also abstain from food or drink (except for water and medicine) for one hour beforehand.
