MESSAGE FROM FATHER GREG

Dear Parishioners:

Thank you for the warm welcome that you have extended to me following the Masses in the parish hall last weekend. Many volunteered to set up, clean up, and provide muffins, sweet breads, crackers, cheese and more. I have also taken part in the Knights of Columbus social and picnic last week and met members, Knights, and families from several councils. I am happy to serve as your pastor at American Martyrs Parish.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be celebrated on Friday, August 15th. Mass on Thursday, August 14th will be at 6:30 pm and Mass on Friday, August 15th will be at 7:00 am & 4:15 pm. Catholics believe that Mary was taken up into heaven, body and soul. Mary’s assumption is a source of hope for us as it reveals that we are destined to be drawn into eternal life with Jesus.

In the Gospel of Luke, we find emphasis on the importance of prayer. This Sunday, we find Jesus in prayer and the disciples ask Jesus to teach them to pray. Luke’s account of the Our Father is shorter than the one in Matthew’s Gospel and still offers much insight into the importance of prayer in the life of the disciples. Notice the emphasis on God as Father and that God’s name is Holy. We are encouraged to pray to God and trust in God’s holy name. Three petitions follow. May God give us daily bread, forgive our sins, and spare us from the final test. Our Catholic tradition contains many prayers and forms of prayer which keep us close to our loving God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
