I have also taken part in the Knights of Columbus social and picnic last week and met members, Knights, and families from several councils. I am happy to serve as your pastor at American Martyrs Parish.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be celebrated on Friday, August 15th. Mass on Thursday, August 14th will be at 6:30 pm and Mass on Friday, August 15th will be at 7:00 am & 4:15 pm. Catholics believe that Mary was taken up into heaven, body and soul. Mary's assumption is a source of hope for us as it reveals that we are destined to be drawn into eternal life with Jesus.
