Dear Parishioners: Last Sunday, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. God is one, and a communion of three divine persons. Baptized in the name of our Triune God, we are called to share in God's divine life and shape our families and communities in God's love.

This Sunday is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Jesus instituted the Eucharist as a sacrament of his abiding presence and has given the Church a perpetual means of sharing the work of his paschal mystery. Today we give thanks and recall our Lord's self-giving of his Body and Blood on the cross, made present for us through sacramental signs.
