Dear Parishioners: Today's readings tell us of God's banquet, a feast of God's healing and care. The Eucharist is the fulfillment of the banquet in Isaiah, and of Jesus' miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fish in the Gospel. Jesus withdrew to a deserted place by himself, the crowds followed him, and he was filled with pity and cured their sick. The stage was set for the realization that the crowd was in a deserted place without provisions. Jesus multiplied the loaves and fish, fed the entire crowd, and baskets of food were left over. When have we found ourselves in need and experienced God's abundant care? St. Paul writes that nothing will separate us from God's love and care through Jesus.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the oldest Marian Feast and Holy Day, will be celebrated on Saturday, August 15th. Even though the obligation to attend Mass is dropped, we still celebrate Mass and invite all to take part. Catholics profess that Mary has gone before us, body, and soul, into heaven. For Mary, the resurrection of the dead has taken place already and we are given the promise of our own path to heaven. The Assumption Mass will take place on Saturday, August 15th at 9:00 am.

The annual Seminararian Retreat will be at St. Albert the Great Parish in Houghton from August 9th to August 12th. This retreat is for men who are discerning a call to the priesthood for our diocese. Fr. Zachary, our new Vocation Director, may be contacted at 906-285-0625.
