The Third Week of Advent. Gaudete means **"rejoice**" in Latin. It comes from the first word of the <u>Entrance antiphon</u> on Sunday. The spirit of joy that begins this week comes from the words of Paul, "The Lord is near." This joyful spirit is marked by the third candle of our Advent wreath, which is rose colored, and the rose colored vestments often used at the <u>Eucharist</u>.
