This free 8-week experience will be held at the Immaculate Conception Parish beginning Tuesday, September 17<sup>th</sup> and run each Tuesday through November 5<sup>th</sup> from 6 pm – 8:15 pm., with half-day retreat on Sat., November 2<sup>nd</sup> from 8 am – 1 pm.
