**SCAM EMAILS AND TEXTS**

There is currently an individual representing themselves as the bishop and other members of the diocesan Curia using email addresses that are not similar to the valid diocesan email addresses used. Diocesan email addresses follow a pattern of [firstinitiallastname@dioceseofmarquette.org](mailto:firstname.lastname@dioceseofmarquette.org) such as: [Tbailey@dioceseofmarquette.org](mailto:Tbailey@dioceseofmarquette.org) The bishop, our priests and employees of the Diocese of Marquette will NEVER request the purchase of gift cards to be sent via text message or email for any type of fundraising project. Regardless of what email address or cell phone number the request comes from, parishioners should NEVER purchase gift cards and send pictures of them via text or email. Scammers are using any information they can find to initiate these requests including information (such as board members' cell numbers or email addresses) on our diocesan website, information in our parish bulletins and on parish websites.
