**MONTH OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD
OF JESUS**

During the month of July, we celebrate the Feast of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus.
In 1849 Pope Pius IX instituted this

celebration, and it has since been observed around the world for centuries. The feast day offers a great opportunity for us to reflect on what the Blood of Jesus means for us in our personal lives and walk of faith. We are born with a sinful nature and have fallen short of God's holy standard. God's holiness requires our sinful nature to be punished and this punishment comes in the form of eternal death. Nothing we can do can let us earn salvation. Jesus was sent to the cross to redeem us from the wages of sin.

Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Jesus' Blood is powerful enough to forgive and cleanse us from sin. Blood is our life force and Jesus' Blood represents His unconditional love for us. He is giving us His essence so we can share eternity with Him and our Heavenly Father.
