FORMATION NEWS – Senior Graduation

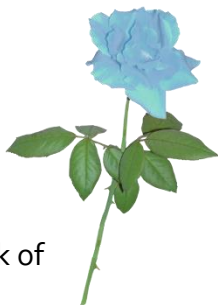

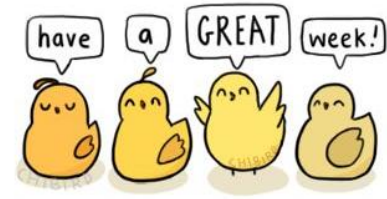
