Please pick up your envelope in the parish entryway. Enclosed, please find a schedule of mass times for Christmas & New Years. During Christmas, we are drawn into the mystery of the Incarnation. During New Year’s, we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God. Please take part in regular Mass, an Advent reconciliation service, and parish/Catholic school programming.

The Thrid Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday, and the rose candle of the Advent wreath is lit. Gaudete means to rejoice, and the readings shift and tell us of the immediate events and people leading to the birth of Jesus.
